While many of you are still experiencing the middle of winter, National Rendezvous will be upon us very quickly.

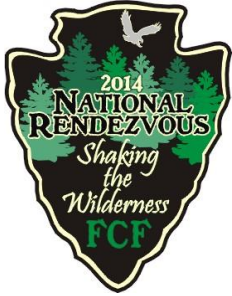

Chapter & Territorial Attendance Goals - The National FCF Staff is committed to making the 2014 National Rendezvous the largest attended FCF event in history. Chapter attendance goals were established at the 2013 LEAD conference. Please do everything in your power to help your territory reach this attendance goal. If all the attendance goals are met, the National Rendezvous will have more than 1600 in attendance. A chapter president will receive a black edition 2014 National Rendezvous patch if they reach at least **100%** of the established attendance goal for their chapter. There will only be 100 of the black edition patches produced. Please review the attached attendance goal document to see the individual attendance goals for each chapter.

Registration Incentives – A drawing will be conducted for all those who have registered before January 31. A National Rendezvous Promo T-shirt will be awarded to three (3) registered individuals. Start registering for rendezvous now.



Chapter Planning for Rendezvous – Start your planning now to attend the 2014 National Rendezvous. The event will be held July 14-18, 2014 at Camp Eagle Rock. Chapters can promote registration, prepare chapter equipment, gather chapter memorabilia (flags, banners, patch collections, historical memorabilia), and encourage chapter members to work on their personal outfits and gear. Volunteer Opportunities at Rendezvous – There will be plenty of opportunities to volunteer your time and service at rendezvous.
