Scout Competition Guidelines – The guidelines for the scout competition have been reviewed and adjusted to better represent a competition solely in the hands of the scout candidates. Changes to the testing criteria include:

1. Trappers Brigade advancement has replaced the popular vote component.
2. Fire starting scoring will be based on levels of time as opposed to a single competitor with one of five scores.
3. RR Advancement now includes Expedition level medals – E2 Medal and E3 Medal.
4. Outfit scoring has been streamlined and simplified with a 100 point scale (divided by 10 to achieve score). New outfit grading components include possibles pouch/bag, necklace, and overall appearance.

The Scout Competition Packet(attached) also includes a completely inclusive score sheet, a standard bull's eye target, the scout application and the personal reference form. Please be reminded that a scout holding any position starting at the area level must have a scout application and 3 personal reference forms on file at the national office.

These guidelines will be in place for scout competitions held at the Territorial Rendezvous' later this year. It is suggested that the new guidelines are used at the area, sectional and chapter levels of competition at the next opportunity.



Territorial Rendezvous' – Please make plans to attend one of the eight Territorial Rendezvous' that will take place later this year. The Territorial Rendezvous is a time for chapter members from across the territory to gather for a time of friendship, competition and spiritual renewal.
