Due to ongoing inquiries received by the national office concerning the status of the *High Adventure*, we are asking that all districts circulate the following information among their outposts to inform them as to the status of this publication and its replacement. Your assistance in this effort would be greatly appreciated.

Announcement Concerning the Status of the *High Adventure* Magazine

In a constant effort to improve the value of Royal Rangers to boys and leaders across the nation, many aspects of our current program have been reevaluated and are in the process of revision. This process has included the *High Adventure* magazine.

For many years, the *High Adventure* has been produced in two editions—one for boys and one for leaders. Although this format had some advantages, it also included limitations. By producing one edition for all boys, kindergarten through high school, the constant challenge was to produce a magazine that would appeal to all boys in a broad age range. Subjects that may be appealing to older boys may be completely irrelevant to boys in our younger groups and vice versa. The overall value of the magazine to boys was, therefore, always limited.

For this reason, after much review, the decision was made to replace the magazine with a new publication, entitled *Rangers NOW*, which will be produced in five separate editions—one for each age group and one for leaders. This publication will be produced annually in the fall of each year to coincide with the new school year. The first edition will be mailed in late fall of 2008 and will be followed each year by a new issue.

It is the continuing effort of the national office to produce resources that will best assist the local outposts in their efforts to evangelize, equip, and empower the next generation of Christlike manhood and lifelong servant leaders.
