I am telling you that is not the truth. I believe God continues to pour out His Spirit on men. I witnessed it in Indianapolis this past weekend when over 65,000 men filled the RCA Dome and were encouraged by the speakers on how to "Live A Legacy". When asked how many were at a Promise Keepers event for the very first time well over half of the men in the stadium raised their hands. Again, when asked how

many fathers and sons were in attendance an overwhelming number of hands went up.

At our meeting, Coach and I agreed to continue to work together to reach men for Christ. He encouraged HonorBound to continue to be bold in the face of criticism and seek God's heart to mentor and disciple men. I told him that we would stand with PK in prayer and endeavors to reach men in this world. It was noted that only 6 percent of the men live in America and we need to reach 100 percent of the men in the world.

I explained that many men ask "What's Next?" after leaving a stadium event. I told him we say HonorBound is "What's Next" because our mission is assimilating men into our churches, discipling, training and molding men into right relationship with Jesus. Men reacting to the world according to the Word of God. Serving their churches, families, communities, and cities as men of Christ.

Coach asked us for prayer for a world outreach to men. He said PK would reorganize and streamline again in October to prepare for the efforts of 1999. Promise Keepers will host 8 events in 1999 around the United States.

The big event will be "1/1/2000" which will be a simulcast of 50 events, one in each state of the union. These 50 events,

# Equipping Pastors With An Effective Men's Ministry

The past 12 months HonorBound has made monumental progress in areas of leadership training materials and seminars, as well as discipleship and evangelism resources for local churches. Though there has been a transition in leadership, the vision and momentum has remained strong.

Our major emphasis this past year has been to equip district and local churches men's ministry leaders with the new HonorBound leadership materials. In February, HonorBound released a new start-up kit for men's ministry in the local church. This \$25 kit contains over \$50 of resources that help leaders launch ministry to men and by men in the local church. It premiers the new HonorBound Local Church Manual. This valuable tool has already helped leaders focus their ministry to growing godly men through the power of the Holy Spirit.

February was also the launch date for the new HonorBound Blueprint For Men's Core Groups. This new seminar was developed jointly with the HonorBound staff and the Promise Keepers National Training Team.

Through the Blueprint Training Seminars, the national HonorBound office is empowering each district to conduct their own district training seminars through its trained and certified trainers. The material is half HonorBound material and half Promise Keepers. In just 6 months, 180-plus trainers have been trained. The empowerment of each district with certified trainers will greatly increase the opportunity for each district in our Fellowship to equip pastors with a quality team of men who can provide effective ministry to men in the church and in the community. The seminar helps men develop a processdriven ministry instead of an eventdriven ministry. The materials are available in English and Spanish and will soon be cross-cultural and crossdenominational. HonorBound is receiving rave reviews from both Promise Keepers and Assemblies of God pastors and laymen for the Blueprint Training Seminar.

In the Discipleship and Evangelism area, HonorBound has released 11 new resources this past year! A new video series that trains men for evangelism tops the list (women who have seen the video love it too). You're A Soul Winner, You Just Don't Know It has just been released. This exciting 8-week video series helps men overcome the fear of witnessing by spurring them on

to a deeper commitment to Jesus Christ and becoming a loving friendly Christian in the marketplace. It opens the eyes of men to meet people at their point of need, allowing the Holy Spirit to open doors for effective evangelism. HonorBound is equipping men with a desire to give every person in every community a clear presentation of the gospel.

In a deliberate effort to promote the vision and name recognition of HonorBound, several promotional items have been developed: a magazine/ catalog, cups, business cards, shirts, hats, cups, lapel pens, posters, banners, etc. Honorline, a new mailer to our District Men's Directors and district officials, was developed to communicate up-to-date information.

The future holds great opportunities to develop men in the Assemblies of God and beyond. The national staff is developing a fathering seminar that will provide a resource for the local church to

developed for 1998-99: Blueprint II, small group resources, Spanish materials, crosscultural materials, plus district directors and sectional rep's manuals.



## The National Camporama Sees Impressive Results

History was in the making July 13-17, 1998, as 5,200 boys and men from across the nation and around the world arrived at Camp Eagle Rock, Missouri. The National Camporama was the largest-ever event since the 1962 inception of Royal Rangers. After 2 years of planning, the Camporama proved most effective. The following reports received reveal the spiritual impact during the four evening services: 1,387 boys committed or recommitted their lives to Christ, 820 boys received the infilling of the Holy Spirit, and 716 boys were called to ministry.

The Camporama was underway Monday, July 13, with the evening service. The Ozarks hills came alive as campers marched into the amphitheater. Each nightly service focused on the Camporama theme "Let Freedom Reign." The presentations came to life through the colorful pageantry, highlighting freedom from personal slavery, political slavery, and social slavery. On Wednesday evening we witnessed per-

haps the largest altar service known to Camp Eagle Rock. Literally thousands of boys and commanders packed around the altar, many remaining until the late hours calling out to God. The final service was action-packed with a patriotic Freedom Rally—in which video drama, music, and fireworks yielded rounds of applause to Christ Jesus.

James Barger, president of the National Royal Rangers Council, was speaker during the July 13 evening service. Fred Deaver, president of the Frontiersmen Camping Fellowship, followed as speaker for the Tuesday evening service. Robb Hawks, foreign missionary, brought a special message the evening of July 15. The grand finale brought a powerful message by Terry Raburn, superintendent of the Peninsular Florida District.

The Camporama was officially underway following the opening ceremony, which began at 9 a.m., July 14. Each district represented one of the six Camporama theme parks as participants paraded about in colorful outfits. A highlight of the ceremony was the impressive air show—which included a tethered hot air ballon, airplane flyovers, acrobatic sky diving, power parachute (ultralight) fly-overs, and miniature airplanes swooping about in impressive grace. National Commander Ken Hunt concluded the ceremony with the words, "Let the 1998 National Camporama begin." His words triggered the release of nearly 500 red, white, and blue balloons and the familiar blast of the FCF cannon.


Called to Ministry

### **OUT OF AFRICA**


It was an honor for me to have been invited to participate in several days of ministry in East Africa between May 28 and June 17. I was impressed with the development and maturity of the national churches I visited. I was also impressed by the level of leadership our Assemblies of God missionaries are giving to that region of the world.

During my time A first ever children's in Africa, I attended Addis Bible College graduation exercises in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. I invited was minister during afternoon Sunday

services in the Addis church, which ministers to over 8,000 people each Sunday. Over 2,000 were in attendance in that service. Upon leaving Addis, I traveled to Nairobi, Kenya, where I visited and spoke to the student body of East Africa School of Theology (EAST). I also traveled out to Maasai Land, where we visited with two Maasai pastors. I preached in Nairobi that Sunday, and next flew on to Malawi.

In addition to visiting the School of Theology in Malawi, I was the featured speaker for all services at the first ever Mangochi District Men's Ministries Conference. The final segment of my trip included a brief layover in Johannesburg, South Africa.

During my time in Africa, I was able to visit with many missionaries to discuss Light for the Lost. Several had exciting stories of how LFTL literature had been used in their area of the continent. While in Nairobi, I even took part in a LFTL reception. During this time,

missionaries one after another testified to the benefits of LFTL literature in their ministries. It is amazing to see how God is using Light for the Lost Bibles and gospel literature in the hands of missionaries around the globe to bring light to the hearts of men.

### **KEY BEARERS UPDATE**

Last month, LFTL reported that \$77,859 had been received for the Key Bearers project. Key Bearers is a cooperative effort between the Pentecostal Evangel and Light for the Lost designed to provide the Evangel free of cost for prisoners. Since that report the amount has gone up to \$85,052. Last year 416,000 Evangels were sent to prisoners through this effort, and we received 1,768 salvation reports. We are excited about the great potential available for reaching even more prisoners this year!
