Eagle Rock Campground

Rick Dostal and Paul Lintner have been working long and hard—well sometimes hard, you know Rick—getting the campground ready with many new improvements for Camporama. We have completed the following:



- shower buildings are completed and ready for block work
- RR Resort and Visitors Center has been brought to grade
- RR Resort "Log Cabin" shell is completed and ready for roofing
- New well has been dug for the RR Resort Center
- Pads are being poured for the cabins adjacent to the Resort Center
- Amphitheater has been expanded to over twice its previous size and is ready for seeding
- New freeway has been completed going into the Amphitheater and roads throughout the campground have been enlarged
- Electrical poles have been set for the three food service locations with the water and septic system installed at the main food service site
- New roof on the shop building next to Paul Lintner's cabin
- Black Powder and Rifle Range is now rough graded to 100 x 325′

- Put a new roof on the caretaker's house
- Complete the Resort Center Log Cabin building
- Build seven cabins on the Resort Center site
- Complete the RV sites adjacent to the Resort Center
- Complete an emergency warning system for the camp
- Expand the existing parking and campsite areas
