National Camporama is like no other event. With participation of Rangers from every state in the U.S.A.

and many foreign countries, we anticipate more than 6,000 campers. If we include visitors, there will be more than 8,000 in attendance! The boys are amazed to see so many Royal Rangers at one location with so many different things to do. They make friends from around the country.

The RR National Championships will be held for district team and/or individual events in air rifle, archery, and Pinewood Derby. Sponsors from Daisy®, NADA (National Alliance for the Development of Archery), Brennan Industries (GenesisTM bow), Bass Pro. and many others will officiate these events.

Nationally-sponsored events and services will be BMX bikes, mountain bikes, hiking trail-walk, trams, low-climbing wall, obstacle course, and FCFsponsored Hawk and Knife throw.

Each district is encouraged to provide an event on the Johnnie Barnes Lodge activities field using their regional theme. Some districts will be overseeing the national events. (See the JB Field layout for the possible arrangement of events and activities.)

We are in the process of constructing a commercial kitchen for Camporama, which will house a professional food service coordinator who will use professional food catering service people and others to assist in this important area. We will have the three food locations to serve the campers.

The evening services will be tremendous, including viewing of video interviews with the boys filmed during that day's activities, music and musicians specifically selected to build the Camporama spirit, and nationally-known speakers:

■ Tom Greene — National Men's Ministries/LFTL director is a tremendous speaker to youth. Tom will be our opening night speaker.

■ Randy Ruiz — Nationally renowned evangelist was saved as a Royal Ranger boy at a powwow in Southern California.

> ■ Dave Roever — Nationally-acclaimed speaker and a tremendous encouragement throughout the country and to our troops.

■ Terry Raburn —Pen-Florida district superintendent, former national and district youth director. Brother Raburn brings our final challenge to take back home.

■ Bob Kilpatrick, back by overwhelming request—live in concert! Bob is no stranger to the Christian music industry. A guitarist and composer of many well-known Christian songs, it is our

delight to be able to have Bob Kilpatrick live on Thursday evening.


Commander, let me encourage you to start planning now. Don't wait until it is too late. District Camporama coordinator, provide your district executive committee and
