1994 National Camporama: This was our largest Camporama ever—boasting 4,000 campers. The spiritual impact on boys' lives was the greatest ever witnessed at a Royal Rangers event; more than 900 boys were saved during the nightly services. In addition, more than 450

Passion Play, presented by the South Texas District. Praises to Christ and rounds of applause enveloped the amphitheater as the character of Jesus Christ was illuminated as He stepped from the tomb—His hands raised to heaven with a note of victory.

Following the pageantry Ken Hunt, national commander, challenged the Rangers to take the gospel message to "the regions beyond." The service concluded with nearly 1,300 boys swarming to the altar. Hundreds of additional Rangers and commanders, unable to move to the altar due to the mass crowd, huddled in small groups throughout the amphitheater, praising God and praying for one another. Boys were praying around the altar past 1:00 a.m. that night as well as the evening before.

Each day was highlighted with an array of activities conducted in the six theme parks. And events such as water sports, chariot races, an orbitron, a water cannon, a BB rifle range, and above-ground swimming pools—naming only a few—kept the boys enjoying each day. Also, national activities provided hot air balloon rides, a ham radio station, acrobatic stunts with a radio controlled airplane, a low ropes course, and a rappelling course that towered 40 feet.

Name Adopted for NRRTC: You will be hearing the National Royal Rangers Training Center referred to in national publications as "Camp Eagle Rock." Though the legal name will remain as is, the national campground will be called Camp Eagle Rock since it is used for Royal Rangers activities other than training.

Our first Junior Councilmen project is now complete, and we have handed to the Division of Home Missions 100,000 Book of Hope Bibles, which were designed to evangelize the African-American youth of the inner cities. The Bible portion contains 16 pages that address youth issues with a gospel message, along with a salvation message.

The first of the 100,000 copies was presented to Rev. Spencer Jones during the July 26-29 Inner-City Workers Conference in New Orleans, Louisiana. Rev. Jones is pastor of Southside Tabernacle in Chicago and outgoing president of the ICWC.

We are preparing to reprint additional copies for DHM at the request of the new church evangelism director, Rev. Harvey Meppelink.

Along with the curriculum the national office encourages outpost commanders to take the 10-hour Turning Point seminar, which teaches commanders about life-controlling problems and how they affect boys and their families.

Turning Point is a new training emphasis adopted by the national office in an endeavor to better equip outpost commanders. Knowing that outpost commanders today—regardless of their geographic location—must help Rangers confronted with life-controlling issues, the national office is implementing the training program, which will be applied from the national to the outpost level.






