RECOGNITION OF A CHURCH with outstanding participation in Men's Fellowship activities is given annually by the Men's Fellowship Department. This year's award goes to the First Assembly of God, Warren, Ohio. Philip Wannemacher recently succeeded Harold Schmitt as pastor of this church.

The MF group was chartered in February 1954 while Herbert E. Eichler was pastor. When land was purchased for the new church building, MF members cleared the land for construction, and later enlarged the parking lot.

In 1962 the Royal Rangers program was started. The commander and lieutenant commander were elected from the Men's Fellowship.

As missionary projects for 1966 the group collected and outfitted a tool box for Missionary Raymond Zents; gave \$50 to Harold Schmitt, former pastor and now a missionary appointee to Germany; and raised \$200 for Light-for-the-Lost.

Approximately 40 men proudly wear the Men's Fellowship lapel pin. A monthly contribution is sent to the national office, and the group subscribes to *Team* magazine.

About half of the men completed the course in personal witnessing, "So Send I You," and have engaged in visitation. On the first Thursday of
