Would I have gone down the wrong road as so many before me have? That is a question I shall never know

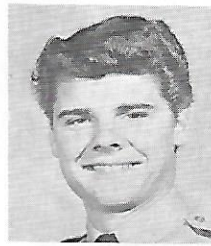
the answer to; for thanks to the Royal Rangers, I have found the right road.

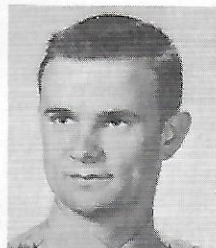
