

Royal Rangers help purchase bus through proceeds from paper drive

ANDERSON, CALIF.—Royal Rangers at First Assembly recently contributed \$550 toward the purchase of a bus for the church. The money was earned through a paper drive which began over nine months ago.

The group, under the leaderof Commander Arden Brazil, began the project to earn money for camping equipment. It proved such a success that they continued the drive and gave the additional funds to the church bus fund.

The congregation and Pastor Jim Logan enthusiastically cooperated with the boys' efforts.

To date over \$800 has come in through the project.
