Top Royal Ranger named for 1984

SPRINGFIELD, MO.—Timothy B. Brecheen of Baton Rouge, La., was selected Royal Ranger of the Year at the Royal Rangers National Rendezvous near West Glacier, Mont., on July 24.

Eight regional winners were evaluated for 5 days before the national winner was named. Competition included a review of their personal achievements and Royal Rangers activities, individual testimonies, letters from school and community leaders, a written test, and personal interviews. The testing also included practical demonstrations of camping skills on an overnight campout, horseback ride, and mountain climb.
