RECIPE CORNER: FRUITY ICE POPS

YOU WILL NEED:

- 8 small paper cups (3 oz. size)
- 8 wooden craft sticks
- 1 cup plain or vanilla yogurt
- 1 cup orange juice
- 1 cup of your favorite fruit cut into small pieces (strawberries work great!)

Mix the yogurt, orange juice and fruit pieces together. Fill the paper cup almost to the top. Insert the wooden stick in the middle. Place in the freezer overnight. When you are ready to eat your ice pop, peel off the paper cup!

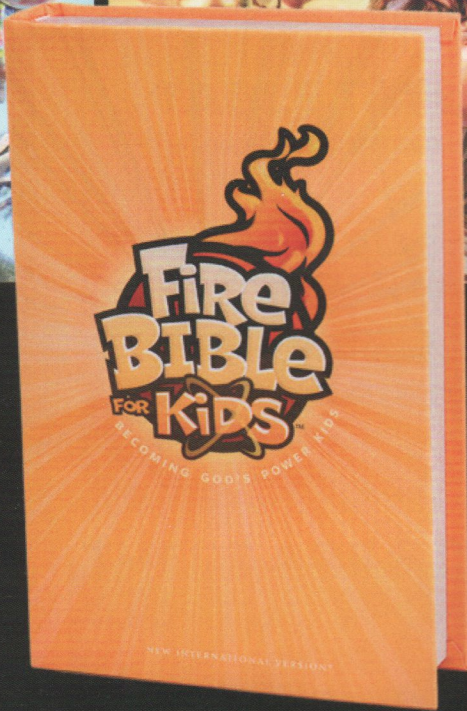
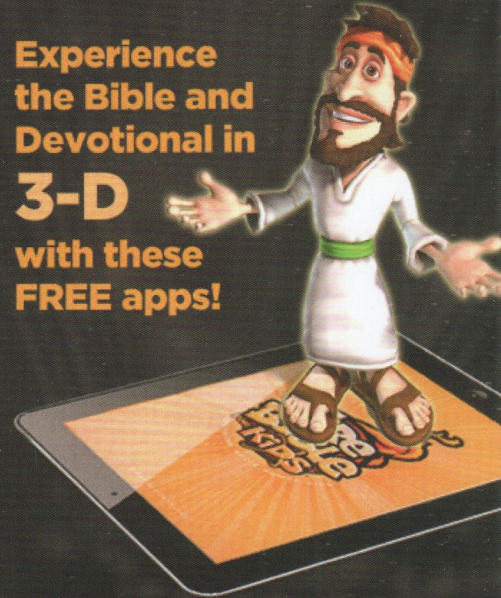
