


## **BREAKAWAYS:** Friday Afternoon

# Featured Speakers





#### Dr. Mark Hausfeld, Morning devotions

Dr. Hausfeld has 25 years of pastoral and missionary vocation in Chicago, Pakistan, and Central Asia. His foci have been and continue to be creative access evangelism, discipleship, and church planting in urban settings in North American and Central Asian Muslim contexts. Dr. Hausfeld and his family lived in Chicago and pastored the church they started for 10 years. From Chicago they went to the Islamic Republic of Pakistan for seven years as missionaries with the Assemblies of God World Missions (AGWM) where they started Teen Challenge Pakistan and assisted two church plants. In 2000, AGWM leadership asked them to serve as area directors for Central Eurasia. In that role, they provided pastoral care, strategic consultation, and administration for AGWM missionaries and national leaders. In January 2009, the Executive Committee of AGWM asked Dr. Hausfeld to serve as International Director of Global Initiative: Reaching Muslim Peoples. The mission of this new ministry is to collaborate with AGWM regions and with US Missions to equip the Church to reach Muslims and to mobilize long term church planting teams.

**Rev. Alton Garrison, Silver Eagle Celebration** — BACK BY (VERY) POPULAR DEMAND As assistant general superintendent, Alton Garrison serves as the executive director for the

Discipleship/Church Ministries Division of The General Council of the Assemblies of God, which includes Royal Rangers.

Prior to his election in 2007, Garrison served as executive director of U.S. Missions from 2005. He served in district leadership in the Arkansas district, including assistant superintendent and superintendent from 2001 until his election to AG U.S. Missions.

Garrison served as lead pastor of First Assembly of God in North Little Rock, Arkansas for 15 years. Throughout his pastorate, the church experienced significant growth, developed extensive lay ministry involvement, and gave millions to missions. Garrison began his pulpit ministry as an evangelist from 1966 to 1985.

Garrison is author of The 360° Disciple, The Acts 2 Church, Hope in America's Crisis, and Building a Winning Team.
