

FEDERAL GET OUT THE VOTE – 2025
OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES
March 31, 2025

This contest is open to Canadian Residents, excluding Quebec, who are currently enrolled in MacEwan University and is governed by Canadian law.

1. CONTEST PERIOD:

The Contest begins on March 31, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. MDT and ends on April 28, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. MDT (the **“Contest Period”**). The Early Bird contest starts on March 31, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. MDT and ends on April 4, 2025 at 11:59 p.m. MDT (the **“Early Bird Contest Period”**, collectively the **“Contest Periods”**).

2. ELIGIBILITY:

This contest is open to Canadian residents who are the age of majority in their province of residence, excluding Quebec residents (**“Entrants”**). Entrants must be a current MacEwan student or a Winter 2025 graduate. The contest is sponsored by the Students’ Association of MacEwan University (SAMU) (the **“Sponsor”**). Employees of SAMU and MacEwan University, including faculty members, are not eligible to enter this contest.

3. HOW TO ENTER:

No purchase necessary. Only one entry per student. To enter, Entrants must fully complete the Contest Entry Form located on www.samu.ca/gotv (the **“Website”**) and follow on-screen instructions which require you to (i) provide your contact information so you may be contacted if your entry is selected in our prize draw (ii) pledge to vote in the 2025 Canadian Federal Election. Once you have fully completed the form, provided contact information and agreed to the Rules, click the submit button to complete your entry (**“Entry”**, collectively **“Entries”**). To be eligible, your Entry must be received within the Contest Period.

4. HOW TO WIN

Winners will be selected by random draw on April 30, 2025 (**“Draw Date”**), from among all eligible Entries received during the Contest Period. The Early Bird prize winners will be selected by random draw on April 9, 2025 (**“Early Bird Draw Date”**, collectively **“Draw Dates”**) from all eligible Entries received during the Early Bird Contest Period. The winners of the Early Bird Contest will remain eligible for the other prize draws including the Grand Prize. Only one prize is permitted per person with the exception of the Early Bird prize winners.

Before being declared a winner, all selected entrants will be required to correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question without mechanical or other aid and sign a prize acceptance form.

The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible Entries received during the Contest Periods.

The Sponsor will make three (3) attempts to contact the selected entrant(s) by telephone or email (using the information provided at the time of entry) within five (5) business days of the Draw Date. If a selected entrant cannot be contacted or has not responded within (10) days of the Draw Date or there is a return of any notification as undeliverable; then that selected entrant will be disqualified and the Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion and subject to time constraints, to randomly select an alternate eligible entrant from among the remaining eligible Entries.

All Entries are subject to verification. The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Sponsor) to participate in this Contest. Failure to provide such proof in a timely manner may result in disqualification.

5. PRIZES

The total value of the prizes is \$2600.00. Early Bird Prizes will be made available for winners to pick up following confirmation of their eligibility. The two \$1000 Tuition Credit Grand Prizes will be arranged through MacEwan University's Registrar Office. All prizes must be accepted as awarded. The Sponsor reserves the right to substitute any of the prizes with other prizes of equal or greater value if any prize cannot be awarded as described for any reason. Prizes are non-transferable and are not redeemable for cash or credit, in whole or in part.

The Sponsor may require winners to sign a liability/publicity release, including a consent to the Sponsor posting the winner's name and photograph on its website or through its social media channels. If a winner fails to return the contest documents within the time specified by the Sponsor, s/he will forfeit their prize, at the discretion of the Sponsor, and an alternate winner will be selected.
