

Early Years Foundation Stage (Nursery and Reception)

Our topic for this term was learning about construction, children in nursery were 'builders'. They used their own imagination to build different kind of houses. They learned mathematical vocabulary to describe different sizes, shapes and measure of the houses. Children had a wonderful experience to see and touch real life animals during the Zoo lab workshop. We went for an Autumn walk to our local park where children observed changes of the Autumn season and collected different shapes and sizes of leaves!

This was a very exciting learning experience for the pupils as they took part in hands-on workshops aiming to improve their understanding of chemistry and its numerous uses in our lives. In addition, they visited an exhibition looking at the remarkable work of different pioneers from different backgrounds and cultures, such as Jabir ibn Hayyan, the great polymath from the 8th century.







Year 5 English Topic-Time Travel

Throughout our Autumn 2 English lessons, we have been reading a book called Tom's Midnight Garden'. We described the garden and we created a 3D model to go with it. Then we watched 'The Chelsea Flower Show and noted down descrip-

Events & Activities

PE Trip—Harrowall—Year 9: 12th November 2019

Year 9 pupils enjoyed an afternoon aiming high as they hiked at one of Europe's largest bouldering centre: 'Harrowall.' Pupils were challenged to climb using technique, balance and strength in an action packed expedition at the centre, led by Ms Teodora.

Secondary: KS3 Library visits: November 2019

Pupils visited the local library to encourage reading for pleasure. Pupils learnt about the history of Hendon library as the first library to facilitate a children's section in the UK pioneered by the resident Hendon librarian Eileen Colwell in the 1930's.

Stand up against discrimination! Workshops: 14th November

Stand Up Against Discrimination! A UK educational Anti-discrimination charity, facilitated innovative workshops for Secondary pupils highlighting social issues such as Bullying, Discrimination and the Media's role in instigating stereotypes; in addition to providing democratic means of speaking out against such injustices.

Art trip - The V & A Museum - Year 10: 15th November 2019

The year 10's visited the Victoria & Albert Museum in Kensington as part of their exploration of diverse objects, led by Ms Maha. Pupils utilised observational skills to reproduce depictions of gallery objects, centred on the theme of Experimental drawing.

Islamic Studies Mosque trips - 19th & 21st November 2019

Pupils have travelled to noted mosques to enhance Islamic knowledge and further experiences regarding the daily functions of places of prayer. Year 7 & 8 explored a local treasure with a trip to Hendon Mosque. Year 9 & 10 were given an inspirational insight into the core tenets of faith at Regents Park Mosque led by Ms Mariam.

English trip—Diversity in Literature Conference: 20th November

The year 10's and 11's attended a conference hosted by Pearson Education in appreciation of diversity within English Literature. Pupils attended talks by a number of well known literary figures including author: Jamila Gavin, Playwright: Tanika Gupta and Poet: Raymond Antrobus.

English trip—The Globe theatre: 25th November 2019

Year 9 & 10 partook in a workshop at the Globe theatre, led by Ms Mariya and Ms Zeina. Pupils gained an insight into the plight of protagonist Shylock, from William Shakespeare's iconic play 'The Merchant of Venice.'

The Alan Senitt Project: 5th December 2019

The Year 10's hosted a seminar for pupils & educators from Hendon school, as part of the Alan Senitt Leadership development project led by Ms Saqiba.

Charity Fitness Event assembly—6th December 2019

Coach Abdul Rahman presented the BHA Charity Fitness Event to Secondary, inviting pupils to participate in a test of physical endurance and mental agility. The assembly focused on the often ignored, yet crucial role of health and fitness in our everyday lives.
