Literacy (Phonics phase 1)

We will be learning to:

- new rhymes and songs.
- develop children's listening skills and awareness of sounds in the environment.
- Read Non-fiction story books from our bookshelves
- Read the story of "Dinosaur Roar" and learn different facts about Dinosaurs' life.
- the name of different dinosaurs and simple fact about them.

Islamic studies

We will be learning about Eid AL Adha and day of Arafat and their importance.

ART & DESIGN

We will be learning to:

- explore story telling resources to create and retell their own dinosaur stories.
- use loose parts and building resources to create with.
- listen to and respond to music to create a dinosaur dance.
- working collaboratively with others to create dinosaur worlds and maps.
- explore mud and clay and using it to represent different ideas.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

We will be learning to:

- Join in with class P.E, developing their throwing, catching and balancing skills.
- practice gross motor skills by developing their running, jumping, skipping.
- refine their handwriting skills including having a good sitting posture.
- refine fine motor skills with our daily activities such as tracing our names/numbers.

MATHS

We will be learning to:

- explore the numbers 5 and 6 and finding out about their composition
- Sort images of 5 and 6
- Learning about the properties of 2D shapes
- Comparing and measuring the height,
- size and length of different dinosaur pictures
- represent the numbers 5 and 6
- use a range of equipment and loose parts

PERSONAL, SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL

We will be learning to:

- join in with group times for shared songs, stories, games and discussions.
- play with others and developing the confidence to express their feelings and needs in appropriate ways.
- regulate our own emotions and using strategies that we have been taught in class.

LANGUAGE & COMMUNICATION

We will be learning to:

- listen, order and retell a range of stories including Dinosaur Roar, Dear Dinosaur.
- Listen to instructions to decorate a dino biscuits.
- Listen to and join in with dinosaur rhymes.
- new vocabulary related to dinosaur's topic such as fossil, extinct, lava, magma...etc.
- dinosaur hunts and dig for fossils.
- Have opportunities to use small world

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

We will be learning to:

- Find out about different paleontologists and their fossil discovery.
- talk about what they see and feel when handling fossils and dinosaur toys.
- look at and experimenting with salt dough and clay.
- having free access to water, sand and natural objects during outdoor/ indoor learning times.
