Literacy

As Readers, we will be learning new rhymes and songs.

In phonics phase 1 aspect 7 we will be learning all about blending and segmenting.

In Reading we will be exploring and reading non-fiction story books from our bookshelves.

We will also be learning about plants, and how to plant a sunflower, and about minibeasts too.

As artists, we will be:

Exploring paint and how colours change.

PHYSICAL Development

Refining their handwriting skills including having a good sitting posture.

Introduce a variety of one-handed tools throughout the nursery, e.g. scissors, and hammers.

Pencil control activity, encouraging children to hold pencils correctly and with good control.

Refining fine motor skills with our daily activities such as tracing our names/numbers. finger exercise time.

MATHS

Exploring the numbers 7 and 8, 9 and 10

. Learning about the properties of 2D Shapes.

Being able to complete, and copy a pattern.

Representing the numbers 5 and 6, 7,8,9,10 using a range of equipment and loose parts.

As global citizens, we will be learning :
