Narrative writing: Children will choose their own legend from based on themes in Native American Culture.

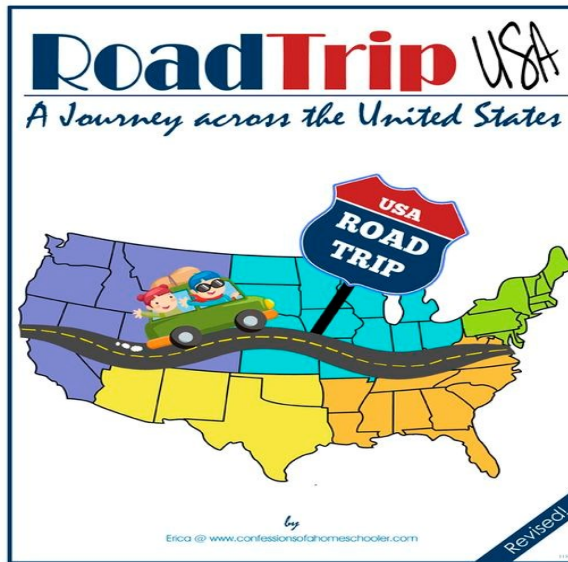

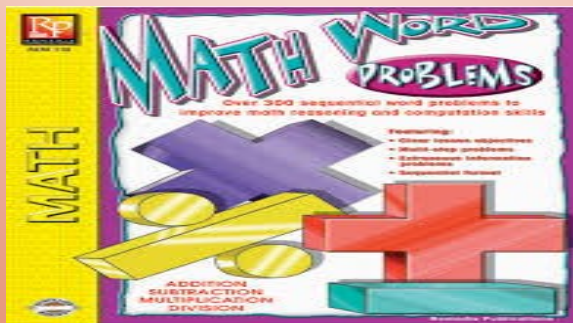
Geography:

In Maths, children will learning about place value, adding and subtractions, multiplication and division. Children will attempt problem solving sums with reasoning.

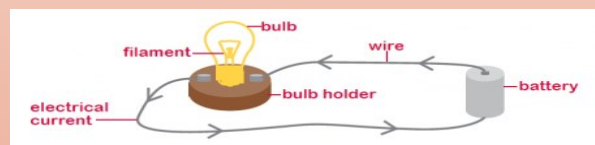

Electricity

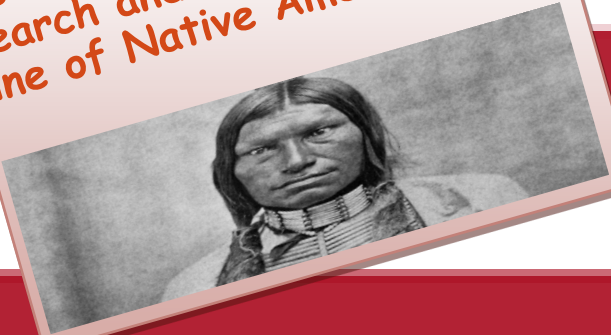
'Visit' Times Square to look at the light! Use components including lamps, batteries) and wire to recreate the circuits and use correct terminology to describe what is happening in the circuits.



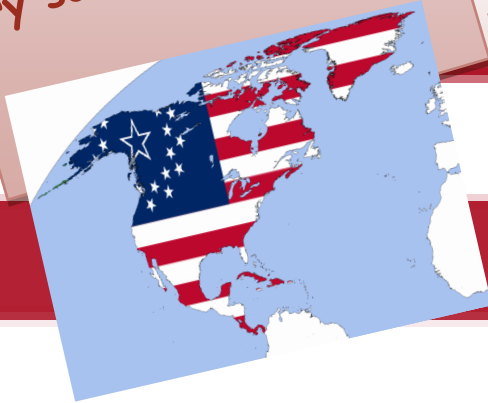
HOME learning IS FUN!
