



## ENGLISH

As **Writers**, we will begin by focusing on 'Stories with Predictable Phrasing' where we will explore the author's use of repeated language, setting, and the characters' appearance and feelings. In 'Instructional Writing', we will have a scrumptious time learning through cooking. This will help us to explore the language features found in recipes, such as 'bossy verbs' and 'time adverbials' (first, then, next).

## ISLAMIC STUDIES

As **Theologians**, we will be exploring the importance of respecting one another, cleanliness, smiling, having politeness in speech, and starting from the right hand. We will also learn the proper etiquette of eating and drinking, sleeping and waking, and using the washroom.

## Art and Design

As **Artists**, our topic is 'Colour Splash', where we will experiment with mixing colours. We will revisit our primary colours and then mix them to create secondary colours. We will then use these in our paintings to create our final masterpiece.

## MATHS

As **Mathematicians**, we will explore **place value within 10**, practising counting forwards and backwards, and using comparative language such as fewer, less than, greater than. Moreover, we will explore **addition** and **subtraction** within 10, adding and subtracting one-digit and two-digit numbers.

## History

As **Historians**, we will focus on our learning question: **How am I making History?** We will develop our understanding of personal chronology, comparing the difference between childhood in the past and in the present. Additionally, we will identify the similarities and differences between now and the past, identifying what has changed and what has stayed the same.

## COMPUTERS

As **Computer Scientists**, we will learn about 'Computing Systems and Networks – Technology Around Us.' We will become more familiar with the different components of a computer by developing our keyboard and mouse skills, and we will start to consider how to use technology responsibly.

## SCIENCE

As **Scientists**, we will investigate 'The Human Body,' exploring the senses associated with each body part. Furthermore, we will identify the 'Seasonal Changes' that occur in autumn, collecting and recording data.

## PSHE

As **Global Citizens**, we will begin by learning that all families are different and will explore what makes families so special. We will also learn how to keep ourselves healthy and safe, as well as how to form caring friendships and behave respectfully toward one another. Finally, we will learn about online safety.

## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

As **Athletes**, our topic is '**Throwing and Catching**', where we will explore how to throw and catch using the correct techniques. Furthermore, we will improve our balance, agility and co-ordination and begin to apply these in a range of activities.
