
As **Readers**, we will be reading the book 'The Lonely Beast' as a class and focus on vocabulary and retrieval questions.


Maths



As **Mathematicians**, we will be learning how to tell the time, how to count our money, how to check the mass of an object and the capacity and volume of any liquid.


Science
