ENGLISH

As Writers, alongside our daily discrete grammar teaching, we will be covering in English lessons: mystery stories and performance poetry. We will be heavily focusing on Reading Comprehension.

ISLAMIC STUDIES

Art

The lessons aim to develop skills in sorting, designing, and evaluating art, encouraging students to present and discuss their creations in a class gallery setting.

MATHS

As Mathematicians, Children will develop understanding of Fractions and time.

Children will recognise, find, name and write fractions $1/3$, $1/4$, $2/4$ and $3/4$ of a length, shape, set of objects or quantity.

Write simple fractions, for example $12 \text{ of } 6 = 3$ and recognise the equivalence of $2/4$ and $1/2$

History

As Historians, we will

- To describe what a monarch is.
- To explain why coronations, take place.
- To explain how William the Conqueror became King of England.
- To identify features of a castle that would be effective when defending against attacks.

COMPUTERS

As Computer Scientists, we will focus on our Creating Media- Digital Media.

Children will learn to recognise that different devices can be used to capture photographs and will gain experience capturing, editing, and improving photos. Finally, they will use this knowledge to recognise that images they see may not be real.

SCIENCE

As Scientists, we will be focusing on Microhabitat.

Children will be asking questions about minibeasts and using scientific enquiry methods to find answers.

As Global Citizens, our topic for next half term will be focusing on Economic Wellbeing. Pupils will be able to:
