Geography: What is it like to live in Kenya?

This half-term, during their geography lessons, Year 2 will be travelling to Kenya and comparing what life is like in this African country compared to the UK. They will be focusing on:

- Where is Kenya located in the world
- What is the climate like in Kenya?
- How do people live in Kenya? What is the Maasai culture like?
- What animals and plants can be found in Kenya
- What human and physical features can be found in Kenya?

Maths

This half-term, year 2 will be reviewing concepts on writing and counting money in addition to extending their knowledge of how to represent money using £ and p. They will then be moving on to calculating total amounts of money and change.

Next, they will be focussing on 2D and 3D shapes including their different properties.

PE

This term's topic is hockey and Year 2 will be learning to

- \Rightarrow Dribble and hold a hockey stick
- $\Rightarrow~$ Control and pass the ball to where there is space
- \Rightarrow Use the defensive position to prepare for tackling
- $\Rightarrow~$ Control and pass the ball unchallenged
- ⇒ Participate in small hockey matches, increasing their agility skills.

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This half-term, the topic for Year 2 is expressive art. Children will learn :

- What does an expressive painting look like?
- How can you make an expressive painting?
- How is brushwork used in expressive art?

- How can you reflect on the work you have created?
