Children will be reading the book "the bee who spoke "


We will continue to develop our reading skills through guided reading and looking at range of non-fiction books



# Science

With a strong science focus Wrigale and Crawl aims to develop children knowledge of living things and their habitats. Pupil will identify, observe and investigate mini beasts and understand life cycles.
