Why did the Romans settle in Britain?

English



As **Writers**, we will create characters and settings when writing adventure stories. We will also be writing persuasively, thinking carefully about how to organise our ideas so that related ideas are built upon within the same paragraphs.

As **Readers**, we will be making predictions about the book, **Survivors Escape from Pompeii**.

Maths



As **Mathematicians**, we will continue to explore working with fractions. We will be finding fractions of whole numbers as part of a set and look at sharing 1 and more than 1. In addition, we will be exploring angles. Looking at making and finding angles in shapes and learn how to name certain angles.

Science



As **Scientists**, we will be learning about Animal including Humans. This project teaches about the importance of nutrition for humans and other animals. We will learn about the role of a skeleton and muscles and identify animals with different types of skeleton.

Islamic Studies



As **Theologians**, we will be studying the story of the prophets Yaqub & Yusuf (a.s), the lessons we can learn from them and how they are relevant to our lives.

Geography / History



As **Historians**, we will be focusing on the Learning question: Why did the Romans settle in Britain? We will be learning about why the Romans invaded Britain, how the Britons responded to the Roman invasion and why the Roman army were so successful and how the Romans changed modern Britain.

As **Global Citizens**, we will be exploring issues and topics relating to living in the wider world. We will research, discuss and debate topical issues, problems and events that are of concern to them and offer possible recommendation.

Art and Design



As **Artists**, we will be diving into the history of mosaic. Focussing on the colours, patterns and themes found in Roman mosaic.
