What are Rivers and how are they used?



English

As **Writers**, we will be concentrating on different narratives and poetry. We will be analysing, understanding and implementing different writing techniques and features.

As **Readers**, we will be reading **The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane**. We will be analysing the vocabulary as we look at the impact of language on readers.



Maths

As **Mathematicians**, we will be focusing on Geometry. We will be classifying triangles and quadrilaterals, looking at different types of angles and working on our timetables.



Science

As **Scientists**, we will be learning about different types of food and the digestive system. We will be focusing on how food gives our body energy and how it is digested in our bodies.



Islamic Studies
