UCFACTS

• The future of college football is at UCF with new head coach Gus Malzahn taking over in Orlando on Feb. 15, 2021. Malzahn previously led Auburn to the BCS National Championship Game in 2013, eight straight years of bowl game appearances with the Tigers, an SEC Championship, two SEC West Division titles, and six New Year's Day bowl selections. He was the National Coach of the Year in 2013.

• Since the start of the 2017 season, UCF has accumulated a record of 41-8. The Knights went 13-0 in 2017, 12-1 in 2018, and 10-3 in 2019, and 6-4 last season. UCF's 35 wins from 2017-19 made UCF one of just six FBS programs in the nation to secure that many victories. The Knights joined Alabama, Clemson, Georgia, Ohio State and Oklahoma in the elite category from 2017-19.

• Having started the program in 1979 and only having been playing at the FBS level since 1996, UCF became the youngest program by 35 years to win a New Year's Six/BCS bowl game when the Knights defeated Baylor in the 2014 Fiesta Bowl. UCF is one of just 16 programs to have appeared in three New Year's Six/BCS bowl games since 2013 and one of only 13 to have won two such games in that span.

• Dillon Gabriel comes into the 2021 season as one of the top returning quarterbacks in the nation, having led the country in passing yards per game last year. His 357.0 passing yards per game also set a UCF record. He has thrown for 7,223 passing yards in just 23 career games and threw for 400 yards or more four times last season. Gabriel is on the watch list for every national quarterback and offensive player of the year award heading into the 2021 campaign.

• UCF had a program record five players selected in the 2021 NFL Draft (Richie Grant, 2nd Round; Aaron Robinson, 3rd Round; Jacob Harris, 4th Round; Tay Gowan, 6th Round; Tre Nixon, 7th Round). It was more than all other AAC teams, 80% of all Big-12 teams, 79% of all Big Ten teams, 79% of ACC teams, 75% of Pac-12 teams and 57% of SEC teams. The Knights have had nine top 100 picks since 2014 and had 24 former players on NFL rosters during the 2021 preseason.

• The UCF football team announced its captains for the 2021 season prior to the start of the campaign, electing four Knights to leadership roles as voted on by their peers. The four captains are senior defensive end Big Kat Bryant, junior quarterback Dillon Gabriel, senior offensive lineman Samuel Jackson and senior wide receiver Brandon Johnson.

UCF and Boise State have never met in the history of the two programs.

The Knights have competed against only four of the 12 current members of the Mountain West Conference, holding a record of 1-4 in those games.

UCF's lone win over the MWC was a 38-6 home victory over New Mexico on Nov. 21, 1998. The Knights also lost to the Lobos 17-7 on the road on Sept. 14, 1996.

The Knights also lost their only matchups with Hawaii, Nevada and Utah State. Their last contest against an MWC team was against Nevada in the 2005 Hawaii Bowl.

THE OPPONENT

Boise State is in its first season under new head coach Andy Avalos after former head coach Bryan Harsin left for Auburn following the 2020 season.

This Broncos went 5-2 in a COVID-19 shortened 2020 season, going a perfect 5-0 in Mountain West Conference action. Boise State lost to then 9th-ranked BYU during the regular season and 25th-rated San Jose State in the MWC Championship Game.

Quarterback Hank Bachmeier returns to lead the offense after throwing for 1,150 yards and six touchdowns in five games a season ago.

The top returning tackler for the defense is Riley Whippey, who had 61 stops and 7.5 TFLs last year.

LAST TIME OUT

The UCF football team closed out the 2020 season at the RoofClaim.com Boca Raton Bowl, falling to 13th-ranked BYU in a score of 49-23 at FAU Stadium in Boca Raton.

BYU (11-1) scored the first 21 points of the game and never looked back, leading 35-10 at halftime and 49-17 after three quarters of play.

Cougars quarterback Zach Wilson was 26-of-34 for 425 yards with three touchdowns through the air. He also ran for two scores on five rushes for 12 yards on the ground. Tyler Allgeier led the BYU ground attack with 19 rushes for 173 yards and a touchdown.

For UCF, quarterback Dillon Gabriel went 21-of-45 for 217 yards and threw two touchdown passes, one to Jaylon Robinson and one to Jacob Harris. Greg McCrae rushed 18 times for 77 yards and a score on the ground.

Jermaine McMillian led a depleted UCF defense with a career-high 11 total tackles, while Tatum Bethune had five tackles and a sack.

It marked the fifth consecutive season that the Knights have played in a bowl game, the first such stretch in program history.



TEAM NOTES

AWESOME ACADEMICS

- This past spring, UCF Athletics extended its streak to 27 consecutive semesters with a department average GPA of 3.0 or better and it marked the ninth straight semester of a 3.2 or better as a department.
- The UCF football team put 49 student-athletes on the American Athletic Conference All-Academic Team this past spring.
- A total of 37 football student-athletes earned Dean's List honors over the course of the 2020-21 school year, with Derek Gainous, Anthony Montalvo and Alex Swenson earning the accolades both semesters.
- Gainous, a senior safety for the Knights, also received CoSIDA Academic All-District honors this past year.

KNIGHTS IN THE NFL

- The UCF football team set a program record this spring when five Knights were selected in the 2021 NFL Draft, topping the previous best of four, attained both in 2003 and 2018.
- Safety Richie Grant went to the Falcons in the second round, cornerback Aaron Robinson was picked by the Giants in the third round, wide receiver/tight end Jacob Harris was snagged by the Rams in the fourth round, cornerback Tay Gowan went to the Cardinals in the sixth round, and wide receiver Tre Nixon was picked by the Patriots in the seventh round.
- In all, UCF totaled more NFL Draft picks in 2021 than all other American Athletic Conference teams, 80 % of all Big 12 teams, 79 % of all Big Ten teams, 79% of all ACC teams, 75 % of all Pac-12 teams, and 57% of all SEC teams.

NATIONAL EXPOSURE

- UCF ranks among the FBS leaders in major network national television appearances by its football team over the last three seasons (ABC, CBS, FOX, NBC, ESPN, ESPN2).
- In 2018, 2019 and 2020, the Knights appeared 26 times on either ABC, ESPN or ESPN2, ranking ninth nationally in that category.
- Two of UCF's first three games of the 2021 season are scheduled to air on ESPN.

BOWLS, BCS AND NEW YEAR'S SIX

- The Knights appeared in their fifth straight bowl game in 2020 (Roofclaim.com Boca Raton Bowl vs. BYU), extending the program record for most consecutive bowl game appearances. UCF played in the Cure Bowl in 2016, the Peach Bowl in 2017, the Fiesta Bowl in 2018 and the Gasparilla Bowl in 2019.
- The 2020 Boca Raton Bowl marked UCF's eighth bowl appearance in the last nine seasons and the Knights' 12th in the past 16 years.
- Since the 2013 season, UCF has appeared in three BCS/New Year's Six bowl games and won two (2014 Fiesta Bowl, 2018 Peach Bowl).
- The Knights are one of only 16 FBS programs in the nation to appear in three such games during that span and one of only 13 teams to win two games during that time.
- UCF is the only non-"Power 5" team to appear on either list.

TRANSFER TIDBITS

- UCF will rely on a significant number of transfers in 2021. Potential starters for the Knights this fall are RB Isaiah Bowser (Northwestern), WR Brandon Johnson (Tennessee), DE Big Kat Bryant (Auburn), DT Ricky Barber (Western Kentucky) and OLB Bryson Armstrong (Kennesaw State), all of whom transferred after the end of the 2020 campaign.
- Other likely regulars who transferred previously are WR Jaylon Robinson (from Oklahoma in '19), TE Jake Hescocock (Wisconsin in '18) and OT Marcus Tatum (Tennessee in '20). Other expected 2021 contributors who came to Orlando via the transfer route include WR Nate Craig-Myers (Colorado State and previously Auburn), WR Jordan Johnson (Notre Dame), K Ryker Casey (Appalachian State) and SS Divaad Wilson (Georgia in '20).

FUTURE FOOTBALL CAMPUS VISION

- On August 19, new UCF director of athletics Terry Mohajir announced his planned vision for UCF Athletics' football campus at the Kenneth G. Dixon Athletics Village.
- UCF's previously announced McNamara Cove that will include a recovery river for student-athletes and "Covegating" experiences for fans on game days is part of the plan.
- Also announced was the Launch Club, a new structure on the south side of the stadium located above the Garvy Center for Nutrition, featuring coaches' offices combined with premium seating areas.
- The north end zone will feature additional seating and standing-room only decks for expansion of the Knightmare Student Section.

OFFENSE NOTES

PRETTY DARN OFFENSIVE

- UCF has ranked in the top eight nationally in both total offense and scoring each of the last three seasons, the only team in the country to accomplish that.
- The Knights scored 30 or more points in 31 straight games from Aug. 31, 2017 to Sept. 28, 2019, which set a record for the longest streak in the Associated Press Poll era (since 1936).
- As the 2021 season starts, UCF has scored 30 or more points in 45 of its last 48 outings.
- UCF has scored 40 or more points in 29 of its last 48 games, has reached the 50-point plateau 15 times in the last 48 outings.
- Last season, the Knights ranked second in the nation in total offense for the second straight year, averaging 568.1 yards per game, an all-time UCF and American Athletic Conference high.
- UCF also ranked fourth in passing, seventh in first downs and eighth in scoring, averaging 42.2 points per game in 2020.

GABRIEL'S GOT IT

- Dillon Gabriel has already made his name as one of the top quarterbacks in the nation and comes into the 2021 season as a PFF preseason honorable mention All-American and a watch list honoree for every national quarterback and player of the year award.
- In 2020 he threw for 3,570 yards and 32 passing touchdowns with only four interceptions in just a 10-game season.
- He earned second-team all-conference accolades from the AAC and led the nation with 357.0 passing yards per game.
- Gabriel's 32 passing touchdowns ranked fourth in the nation and were the second most in a single season in UCF history.
- As a sophomore he threw for 400 or more yards in four games in 2020, which was more than any other Knight has done in an entire career.
- Gabriel is one of three UCF quarterbacks to throw for 3,000 yards in multiple seasons (Daunte Culpepper, 1997 and '98; Blake Bortles, 2012 and '13) and would be the first with three 3,000 seasons if he accomplished the feat in 2021.

THE BIG BOYS ARE BACK

- UCF returns its an entire offensive line from last season, which includes six different o-linemen that started games in 2020.
- Both Matthew Lee at center and Edward Collins at tackle started all 10 games a season ago, while Cole Schneider started nine times at guard, Samuel Jackson started eight times at both guard and tackle, Lokahi Pauole started eight times at guard, and Marcus Tatum started five times at tackle.
- Between the six of them, the offensive linemen have combined for 88 career starts at UCF and 99 total collegiate starts, including Tatum's 11 starts at Tennessee.
- Schneider leads the pack with 34 career starts in his time at UCF.

FLASH AND MOVING FORWARD

- Dillon Gabriel's top returning target is Jaylon "Flash" Robinson, who totaled 979 yards and six touchdowns in his first season with the Knights in 2020.
- Jay Flash earned first-team all-conference honors in the AAC as a sophomore, ranking 14th in the nation in receiving yards.
- Robinson went over 100 yards six times on the season, which tied for the third most in UCF history.
- Ryan O'Keefe is the only receiver with much game experience at UCF to return, having caught 20 passes for 391 yards and three touchdowns in 2020, and hauling in seven balls for 74 yards as a freshman.
- The Knights will have to replace NFL draftees Tre Nixon and Jacob Harris, as well as last season's leading receiver Marlon Williams.
- That trio combined for 120 receptions, 1,838 receiving yards and 20 touchdown receptions last season.
- Graduate transfer Brandon Johnson brings on a wealth of experience from Tennessee, having caught 79 passes for 969 in three seasons with the Vols.
- While mostly a blocking tight end, Jake Hescocock returns to the fold with his extra COVID-19 year of eligibility, bringing with him 35 games played, 21 receptions, 153 receiving yards and six touchdowns.

REPLACING THE RUNNING BACKS

- The UCF rushing attack is going to look a lot different in 2021, as the Knights replace their top three running backs from a season ago in Greg McCrae, Otis Anderson and Bentavious Thompson.
- The most experienced back in the room is graduate transfer Isaiah Bowser, who enters his first at UCF after playing three seasons at Northwestern.
- Bowser totaled 334 carries for 1,300 yards and seven touchdowns with the Wildcats.
- Sophomore John Johnny Richardson, redshirt sophomore Damarius Good, Auburn transfer Mark-Antony Richards, redshirt junior Trillion Coles and freshman Anthony Williams will look to give the Knights depth at the position.



DEFENSE NOTES

TURNING THINGS AROUND

- New defensive coordinator Travis Williams will have the task of turning around UCF's defense that ranked 123rd in the nation in total defense a season ago, allowing 491.8 yards per game.
- The Knights were 92nd in scoring defense in 2020, giving up 33.2 points per game.
- Williams comes to UCF after having worked on Malzahn's staff at Auburn since 2014.
- With Williams on staff, Auburn ranked in the top 17 in the nation in scoring defense in four of the last five seasons.
- A former linebacker for the Tigers, Williams led the Auburn linebacker corps to a top five ranking in rushing touchdowns allowed over a five-season span, allowing just 54 scores on the ground.

TURNOVER TOWN

- The Knight defense did have success turning opponents over in 2020, ranking sixth in the nation with 22 turnovers gained, which helped the Knights rank fifth with a 1.20 turnover margin.
- In fact, UCF led the entire nation in fumbles recovered last season, totaling 13 in a 10-game season.
- The Knights were 6-0 when recording more takeaways than their opponent and 0-4 when having an equal amount of turnovers last season. UCF did not give the ball away more times than its opponent in any game in 2020.

LOADED AT LINEBACKER

- The one area of the defense that UCF returns all of its experience from a year ago is linebacker, bringing back starters Eriq Gilyard and Tatum Bethune, as well as key reserve Jeremiah Jean-Baptiste.
- Gilyard was second on the team with 59 tackles, led the way with 8.5 tackles for loss, had a sack, an interception, forced three fumbles and recovered two in 10 games last year.
- Bethune was third on the team in tackles with 57, adding 7.0 tackles for loss, 2.5 sacks, and a pick.
- The Knights also added former FCS All-American Bryson Armstrong as a graduate transfer from Kennesaw State. Armstrong is a two-time Big South Defensive Player of the Year and has totaled 40 tackles for loss and 18.5 sacks in his career.

WHO'S BACK IN THE BACKFIELD?

- All-conference defensive backs and NFL draft picks Richie Grant and Aaron Robinson, as well as NFL draft selection Tay Gowan are not back.
- Fortunately a pair of cornerbacks in Davonte Brown and Corey Thornton combined for 15 starts as true freshmen last season. The two return as sophomores to lead the corners.
- Derek Gainous, Divaad Wilson and Quadric Bullard have all had experience at safety.

REVAMPED D-LINE

- With the addition of Auburn transfer Big Kat Bryant and the return of Kalia Davis, who opted out last season due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the UCF defensive line looks to be much improved in 2021.
- Bryant was a second-team all-conference selection in the SEC last season, making nine starts, three sacks and an interception in 2020.
- Davis, in his last season on the field in 2019, had 8.0 tackles for loss and was a first-team all-conference selection by Pro Football Focus.

SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES

KICKIN' IT

- Daniel Obarski is the only UCF kicker on the roster with experience kicking field goals at the collegiate level, having gone 12-of-17 and scoring 82 points as a sophomore for the Knights in 2020.
- The Knights also brought in transfer kickers Ryker Casey from Appalachian State and Garin Boniol from Louisiana Tech.

OH OH IT'S OSTEEN

- Andrew Osteen returns for his third season on punting duties for the Knights in 2021, ranking ninth in UCF history with 97 career punts, seventh with 4,164 career yards punting, and second with a 42.9 yards per punt average.
- Last season, he punted 40 times for 1,756 yards, an average of 43.9 yards per punt, which ranked third in the AAC.
- Osteen was honored by the Ray Guy Award as a member of its preseason watch list for 2021.

OTHER SPECIALTIES

- Alex Ward returns to snapping duties as a redshirt senior and was among those honored on the Patrick Mannelly Award preseason watch list this summer.
- The Knights return both of their kick returners from last season. Ryan O'Keefe returned 11 kicks for 240 yards for an average of 21.8 yards per return, while Johnny Richardson returned four kicks for 77 yards, an average of 19.2 yards per return.
- Amari Johnson is the only returning Knights who returned a punt in 2020, bringing three back for 24 yards.

Gus Malzahn, who led Auburn to the Bowl Championship Series National Championship Game following the 2013 season in the first of eight straight years his Tigers qualified for bowl games, was named the ninth head football coach at UCF on Feb. 15, 2021.

In eight years as head football coach at Auburn, Gus Malzahn also led the Tigers to a Southeastern Conference Championship, two SEC West Division titles and six New Year's Day bowl selections among those eight postseason appearances.

Malzahn, 77-38 in nine seasons overall as a head coach, has helped teams to seven conference championship game appearances in his 15 seasons as a collegiate coach, including winning a pair of SEC Championships at Auburn (2010, 2013) and a Sun Belt Championship at Arkansas State in 2012. In the final Associated Press rankings his Auburn teams finished second (2013), 10th (2017), 22nd (2014) and 24th (2016).

"When I started the search process, it became very evident very quickly that, based on the conversations I had with the players last week and what they told me were looking for, Gus Malzahn was the guy for the job," said Mohajir. "He has won at every level, and he has coached a Heisman Trophy winner and NFL draft picks. There has never been a better time for Coach Malzahn to lead this program than right now."

"I'm thrilled to be the head coach at UCF, and I'm truly looking forward to being part of Knight Nation," said Malzahn. "It's exciting to be head of a program where the future is extremely bright. I will be hitting the ground running in terms of getting to know our team and everyone else connected with UCF. Our goal is to be ready to win championships."

The 2013 Bear Bryant, Bobby Bowden, Eddie Robinson, Home Depot, Sporting News, SB Nation, Liberty Mutual and Associated Press National Coach of the Year, Malzahn earned SEC Coach-of-the-Year honors that season after guiding Auburn to the biggest turnaround in SEC history. He led the Tigers to a 12-2 record and one of the most memorable seasons in school history in 2013, with historic wins over Georgia and top-ranked Alabama and a record-setting SEC Championship Game win over fifth-ranked Missouri. He became just the third coach in SEC history to win an SEC title in his first year at a school, joining LSU's Bernie Moore in 1935 and Ole Miss' John Vaught in 1947.

The 34-28 victory over top-rated Alabama in 2013 came on a memorable 100-yard return of a Tide missed field goal on the final play of the game. Malzahn's Tiger squads also defeated seventh-ranked Texas A&M in 2013, seventh-ranked Ole Miss in 2014, second-ranked Georgia and top-rated Alabama in 2017 and fifth-ranked Alabama in 2019.

After his eight seasons at Auburn, Malzahn qualified as the second-longest tenured head coach at one school in the SEC. He is one of only 10 active FBS head coaches to take a team to a national championship game. During his time with the Tigers, Auburn was one of only three SEC schools to play in multiple SEC Championships games and play for a national championship.

Malzahn has produced 15 1,000-yard rushers in 15 seasons as a college coach, including Heisman Trophy finalist Tre Mason (1,816) and Nick Marshall (1,068) in 2013 and Cameron-Artis Payne (1,608) in 2014. Kamryn Pettway ran for 1,123 yards in 2016 (despite missing significant time with injuries) and Kerryon Johnson led the SEC with 1,320 yards in 2017.

On three occasions, Malzahn has had two 1,000-yard rushers in the same season: 2013 and 2010 (both Auburn) and 2006 (Arkansas). Malzahn has also coached five 1,000-yard receivers and three 3,000-yard passers. His 2007 Tulsa team had three 1,000-yard receivers.

During Malzahn's eight years at Auburn, the Tigers had the top rushing offense in the SEC, averaging 228.6 yards per game. In 2013, Auburn led the nation in rushing at 328.3 yards per game, the first SEC team to do so. Three of the top six team rushing totals in SEC history (2010, 2013, 2016) came under Malzahn's leadership. Auburn became just the second team in SEC history to gain more than 7,000 yards of total offense in a season in 2013, finishing the year with 7,018 yards (also Texas A&M in 2012).

The Tigers set a school record with 48 rushing touchdowns in 2013 and set a school record against SEC opponents with 677 yards of total offense versus Missouri in the SEC Championship Game. The Tigers set SEC Championship Game team records with 26 rushing first downs, 74 rushing attempts, 545 rushing yards and seven rushing TDs.

Tre Mason, a Heisman Trophy finalist and 2013 SEC Player of the Year, ranked third in the nation with 23 TDs, was fifth nationally with 1,816 yards rushing, sixth with 10.7 points per game, sixth with 169.57 all-purpose yards per game and eighth with 129.7 rushing yards per game. Mason set the Auburn single-season record with 1,816 rushing yards and 2,374 all-purpose yards and was second with 317 rushing attempts. His 46 rushing attempts and 304 rushing yards vs. No. 5 Missouri set SEC Championship Game records and fell three yards shy of the Auburn record.

In Malzahn's eight seasons 32 players were selected in the National Football League draft, including four first-round draft picks—including Derrick Brown (No. 7) and Noah Igbinoghene (No. 30) in the 2020 NFL Draft. Malzahn's other first-round picks include Greg Robinson (No. 2 overall) and Dee Ford (No. 23) in the 2014 draft. In the last two drafts, 12 Auburn players have been drafted, the most for the Tigers



in a two-year span in the common draft era.

Malzahn coached 14 All-Americans as head coach at Auburn, including consensus selections center Reese Dismukes (2014) and defensive lineman Derrick Brown (2019). Brown won the Lott IMPACT Trophy in 2019, while Dismukes was named the 2014 Rimington Award winner as the nation's top center.

The Tigers faced the nation's most difficult schedule collectively during Malzahn's eight years at Auburn, facing 38 ranked opponents, including 21 in the top 10. Auburn was the nation's only program in 2016 to face both the No. 1- and No. 2-ranked programs and in 2017 it faced three of the four College Football Playoff semifinalists a total of four times, earning two wins.

Malzahn and his coaching proved highly successful on the recruiting trail, recording five consecutive top-10 nationally ranked recruiting classes, a first in Auburn history. Six of his eight recruiting classes rated in the top 11 nationally.

Malzahn, who won the Broyles Award as the nation's top assistant coach in 2010 while helping the Tigers to the national title, returned to Auburn after serving as the head coach at Arkansas State in 2012 when he led the program to a 9-3 regular-season mark and the Sun Belt Conference title. Mohajir was named the Red Wolves' vice chancellor and director of athletics in the middle of that 2012 season and remained in that role until coming to UCF last week.

As offensive coordinator, Malzahn made an immediate impact during his tenure at Auburn, highlighted by a record-setting offense in 2010 when the Tigers finished 14-0 and claimed the school's first national title since 1957. Malzahn's arrival in 2009 and style of offense marked a drastic turnaround from the 2008 season when Auburn struggled offensively. In a two-year period, the Tigers improved from a tie for 110th to seventh in the nation in scoring offense (from 17.3 to 41.2) and from 104th to seventh in total offense.

The 2010 Auburn offense set nine school records, while leading the SEC and finished in the top 10 nationally in six statistical categories. He coached Heisman Trophy winner Cam Newton, who had one of the best single-season performances at the position in college football history. Newton threw for 2,908 yards and 30 TDs, while rushing for 1,586 yards and 20 TDs. Newton, the No. 1 overall draft pick in the 2011 NFL Draft, also won the Davey O'Brien, Manning and Maxwell Award.

During two seasons (2007-08) as assistant head coach and co-offensive coordinator at Tulsa, Malzahn's offenses were among the nation's finest, ranking first nationally in total offense. Tulsa's offense in 2007 established nine team and 12 individual school records. The 2008 Tulsa offense averaged 569.9 yards per game and was second nationally, averaging 47.2 points per games. Malzahn in 2006 spent one season at Arkansas as offensive coordinator, coaching Heisman Trophy runner-up Darren McFadden and helping the SEC West champion Razorbacks finish fourth nationally in rushing offense

Malzahn's coaching career began in his home state of Arkansas at the high school level. In 14 seasons as a high school head coach, Malzahn led seven teams to the state championship game and won three titles. In July 2013, he was inducted into the Arkansas High School Sports Hall of Fame. After one year as defensive coordinator in 191 he spent four years (1992-95) as head coach at Hughes (Arkansas) High School, five years (1996-2000) as head coach at Shiloh (Arkansas) High School and five years (2001-05) as head coach at Springdale (Arkansas) High School.

Born in Irving, Texas, Malzahn graduated from high school in Fort Smith, Arkansas, and played football at Arkansas (wide receiver in 1984-85) and Henderson State (receiver and punter in 1988-89), earning his bachelor's degree from Henderson State in 1990. As a player he helped the Razorbacks to the 1984 Liberty Bowl and the 1985 Holiday Bowl (a win over Arizona State).

Malzahn and his wife Kristi (Otwell) are parents of two daughters, Kylie (Collin) Peek and Kenzie (Charl) Stander.

PRODUCTIVE OFFENSES

Gus Malzahn was responsible for two of the four most productive offenses in SEC history: Auburn in 2013 (7,018 yards of total offense and Auburn in 2010 (6,989 yards of total offense).

50-POINT GAMES

Since the year 2000, in the eight years Malzahn was at Auburn, the Tigers posted 25 50-point games. In the 10 seasons without Malzahn, Auburn recorded just seven 50-point games. The Tigers recorded three 50-point games in a season four times with Malzahn as head coach (2013, 2016, 2018, 2019)

MALZAHN AT HOME

Malzahn holds a record of 50-12 (.806) at home as a collegiate head coach. He was 5-1 in 2012 at Arkansas State, and at Auburn went 8-0 in 2013, 6-1 in 2014, 3-4 in 2015, 6-2 in 2016, 7-0 in 2017, 5-2 in 2018, 6-1 in 2019 and 4-1 in 2020. He started his tenure at Auburn with 13 consecutive home victories.

NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR

Gus Malzahn earned multiple national coach of the year awards in 2013, including the Eddie Robinson Award, the Bobby Bowden Award, and the Bear Bryant Award, as well as national coach of the year honors from Home Depot, the Associated Press, Liberty Mutual, Sporting News, SB Nation, and USSA Amos Alonzo Stagg.
