UTSA adds Marcellus Wilkerson to 2023 class on National Signing Day

SAN ANTONIO — UTSA head football coach Jeff Traylor on Wednesday announced that the program has added Marcellus Wilkerson, a transfer from Garden City Community College, to the 2023 signing class, which now totals 25 student-athletes.

Wilkerson played nine games at safety for the Broncbusters in 2022, totaling 31 tackles, including 17 solo stops and 4.5 tackles for loss. Originally from Fort Worth, Texas, he was the District 3-6A Co-All-Purpose Player of the Year as a senior at Boswell High School.

Of UTSA's 25 signees, 17 hail from the state of Texas with seven from the Greater Houston Area, five from East Texas, three from the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex and a pair from Central Texas. There are two signees from Georgia and one each from Alabama, Hawai'i, Louisiana, Mississippi and Pennsylvania, as well as the program's first-ever player from American Samoa.

The group features a near-even split of 13 who come from the high school ranks and 12 transfers. Of the transfers, four are moving to San Antonio from an FBS or FCS program while eight last played at a junior college.

Fifteen members of the class are offensive players, while 10 are pegged for the defensive side of the ball.

Rusk, Texas (Rusk HS/Colorado)

A left-handed quarterback transfer from Colorado who played as a true freshman for the Buffaloes, appearing in four games with three starts ... completed 57 of 100 passes for 600 yards and two touchdowns, also carrying the ball for 38 yards and a pair of scores ... in his first career start, completed 26 passes for 258 yards and a touchdown against UCLA — the second-most passing yards for a debut in program history ... was a consensus three-star recruit coming out of Rusk High School in East Texas ... Rivals ranked him as the No. 26 quarterback in the class and No. 67 player from Texas, 247Sports Composite listed him as the No. 48 quarterback and No. 106 Texas player, while ESPN listed him as the No. 47 quarterback, No. 159 player from Texas and No. 214 player from the region ... started his career in Charlotte, N.C. at Myers Park High School, playing his final two seasons at Rusk ... produced a 39-12 career record and completed 363-of-588 passes for 4,576 yards with 45 touchdowns, also rushing 176 times for 678 yards and 20 scores ... helped guide Rusk to a 9-3 record in 2021 for a four-win improvement ... was named the District 10-4A-II Offensive MVP, first-team all-district and honorable mention all-state as a senior after completing 262 of 388 passes for 3,362 yards with 36 touchdowns, running the ball 88 times for 371 yards and 11 scores ... also played basketball and competed in track & field ... as a guard in basketball for the Eagles, was named first-team All-District 17-4A in both his junior and senior seasons ... averaged 19.6 points and 5.3 assists per game his junior campaign ... his father, Josh McCown played at Sam Houston State before being drafted in the third round of the NFL Draft and played 17 seasons as an NFL quarterback before his retirement in 2020 ... both of his uncles played college football — Randy McCown was a quarterback at Texas A&M, while Luke McCown was a quarterback at Louisiana Tech and went on to a 17-year NFL career, retiring in 2017 ... all three McCown brothers were coached by Jeff Traylor at Jacksonville High School.

Houston, Texas (Bellaire HS/Kilgore College)

A transfer wide receiver and NJCAA All-America returner from Kilgore College ... played 12 games as a sophomore at Kilgore, reeling in 35 receptions for 682 yards and five touchdowns, averaging 19.5 yards per catch ... ranked ninth overall across the NJCAA for receiving yards and fourth in Region XIV for receiving yards, receptions, yards per game (56.8) and touchdowns ... named a 2022 first-team NJCAA Division I All-American as a return specialist after recording 12 kick returns for an NJCAA sixth-most 447 yards (37.3 avg) and division-leading two touchdowns, in addition to a Region XIV third-most 135 punt return yards off seven returns, accounting for two TDs ... the Rangers went 8-4 in 2022, defeating New Mexico Military Institute for the Southwest Junior College Football Conference (SWJCFC) Championship, going on to play Butler Community College in the NJCAA national semifinals ... as a freshman at Kilgore, recorded 25 receptions for 621 yards and five touchdowns, returning eight kicks for 183 yards ... Received All-SWJCFC honorable mention on offense ... a consensus three-star recruit ... ranked as the No. 31 junior college prospect and No. 3 junior college wide receiver by 247Sports, the No. 42 junior college player by Rivals and is No. 34 in the ESPN JC50 ... played his prep career at Bellaire High School in the Houston Metro ... as a senior wide receiver, caught 58 passes for 887 yards and 10 touchdowns, averaging 15.3 yards per play and 98.6 per game ... earned first-team All-District 18-6A honors on offense ... was named to the 18-6A All-District Second Team on defense that same season, recording 24 tackles with one interception and nine pass breakups ... during his junior season, reeled in 51 receptions for 548 yards and four touchdowns ... returned 25 kicks as an upperclassman for 657 yards.

UTSA announces 22 signees on first day of early signing period

SAN ANTONIO — UTSA head football coach Jeff Traylor on Wednesday announced 22 signees on the first day of the early signing period, which runs through Friday, Dec. 23.

Of the 22 signees, 14 hail from the state of Texas with six from the Greater Houston Area, four from East Texas and two apiece from the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex and Central Texas. There are two signees from Georgia and one each from Alabama, Hawai'i, Louisiana, Mississippi and Pennsylvania, as well as the program's first-ever player from American Samoa.

The group features 13 who are coming from the high school ranks and nine transfers. Of the transfers, three are moving to San Antonio from an FBS or FCS program while the other six last played at a junior college.

Fourteen members of the class are offensive players, while eight are pegged for the defensive side of the ball.
