

# QUICK HITS---

- The UConn Huskies return to Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field on Saturday afternoon for the 2024 home opener against Merrimack College. Kick-off is scheduled for 12:03 pm and will on TV across Connecticut on WFSB-3 and WWAX and streamed on UConn+.
- The Huskies head into Saturday's match-up looking to rebound from a 50-7 season-opening loss on the road at the BigTen's Maryland last weekend. The Warriors head to East Hartford off a 21-6 loss at Air Force in their season-opener last Saturday. This will mark the first-ever match-up between UConn and Merrimack, who plays as a FCS Independent.
- UConn played at least one Football Championship Subdivision school in each season since joining the Football Bowl Subdivision in 2002. UConn is 20-2 overall against FCS opponents. UConn logged victories against: Florida Atlantic (2002), Lehigh (2003), Murray State (2004), Liberty (2005), Rhode Island (2006), Maine (2007) and Hofstra (2008), Rhode Island (2009), Texas Southern (2010), Fordham (2011), UMass (2012), Stony Brook (2014), Villanova in 2015, Maine (2016), Holy Cross (2017), Rhode Island (2018), Wagner (2019), Yale (2021), Central Connecticut (2022), and Sacred Heart (2023) with losses to Holy Cross (2021) and Towson (2013).
- Saturday's home opener will kick-off a stretch of seven of the next eight games in the friendly confines of Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. The Huskies are 14-6 in home openers at The Rent. Following next week's trip to Duke, the Huskies will play six-straight at home. For the first time since the 2016 season, the Huskies will play seven home games in a season.
- UConn Head Coach Mora returns for his third season leading the Huskies. Mora guided UConn to a 6-7 record in year one and brought the Huskies back to a postseason bowl game for the first time since the 2015 season. After a 1-4 start to the season, Mora led UConn to a 5-2 run through the rest of the regular season to become bowl eligible. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.
- THE STADIUM: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and begin their 21st season of play at their off-campus home in 2024. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 70-58 at Rentschler Field and a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

# Scouting the Warriors...

The Merrimack Warriors are in their first season competing as a FCS Independent in 2024 and are under the guidance of first year head coach Mike Gennetti. He is the program's fifth ever head coach but has been at Merrimack for 19 seasons, most recently as the team's defensive coordinator. Merrimack made the transition up to FCS in 2019 and up through last season played in the Northeast Conference. The Warriors are headed to East Hartford for the program's third-ever game against a FBS opponent and are coming off a 21-6 loss on the road at Air Force last week. Last season, Merriamack lost to UMass 31-21. In last weekend's season-opening loss to the Falcons, the Merrimack defense held Air Force to just 237 yards of total offense, 166 on the ground. On the flip side, the Warriors were held in check until the game's final play, an Ayden Pereira to Jalen McDonald 11yard touchdown. Wide receiver Donovan Wadley was named to the preseason Walter Payton Award Watch List. He caught 26 passes for a total of 471 yards and five touchdowns and ran it 34 times for 216 yards, scoring three touchdowns last season. He also was the NCAA statistical leader in yards per kick return last season with a 37.9 average, returning three kickoffs for touchdowns. Defensively last season, the Warriors led the NEC in rushing defense and were led by linebacker DJ Frazier who was the team's top-tackler with 52 stops. Defensive back Tre Jordan III had three interceptions last season.





# Head Coach Jim Mora

Head Coach Jim Mora will begin his third season on the UConn sidelines in 2024. Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896.

In his first season in Storrs in 2022, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschlar Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

Following the 2023 season, the Huskies saw the program's first twotime All-American during the FBS era in offensive guard Christian

Haynes, who garnered AP and The Sporting News All-American honors for the second consecutive season. Haynes also became the first NFL Draft pick under Mora when he was selected in the third round by the Seattle Seahawks.

"Jim is a proven winner, a man of integrity, and he possesses the experience and the energy to lead our football program back to success," said David Benedict, UConn Director of Athletics, upon Mora's hiring. "Jim is excited and undaunted by this challenge, and we both know that this program has great potential. I'm certain that, under Coach Mora's leadership, UConn football will once again realize that potential."

Mora, 60, brings 31 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 10 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

"I am excited to have the opportunity to become the head football coach at the University of Connecticut," Mora said. "UConn possesses a nationally-recognized academic and athletics brand and I am thrilled to become a member of the community that makes up UConn Nation. This program is loaded with potential."

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego, Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota.

Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

# **NEWS & NOTES ---**

**Bell Gets 100 in Husky Debut...** R-Junior wideout Skyler Bell hauled in five passes for 141 yards in his UConn debut at Maryland since transferring in from Wisconsin last spring. Bell hit the century mark, a first by a UConn wideout since the 2021 season when Keelan Marion had 102 yards at Vanderbilt. For Bell, it was his second career 100-yard game, his first coming in 2022 at Wisconsin when he had four catches for 108 yards and two scores against New Mexico State.

First Career Start for Evers... R-Sophomore Nick Evers was named the Huskies's starter at the end of summer camp and made his first collegiate start in last Saturday's loss at Maryland. Evers joined the Huskies after spring, transferring in from Wisconsin. He finished the game six-of-17 for 73 yards and an interception before leaving the game in the third quarter. R-senior Joe Fagnano came in and led the lone UConn scoring drive. He finished eight-of-16 for 149 yards and a score. Fagnano won the starting quarterback job out of camp last season but saw his season come to an end in game two with a shoulder injury. Fagnano transferred in to UConn at the start of last season from Maine, where he was coming off a season in which he threw for 2,231 yards and 15 touchdowns. Fagnano was named to the 2024 Comeback Player of the Year watch list this preseason.

**Sheffield Catches First TD...** R-Senior wide-out TJ Sheffield caught his first touchdown as a Husky in the loss at Maryland. Sheffield finished the game with two catches for 32 yards, including a third quarter 27-yard hook-up with back-up quarterback Joe Fagnano. While at Purdue, he caught 118 passes in 46 games for 1,209 yards and 11 touchdowns.

Defensive Notes from Maryland... UConn senior linebacker Amir Renwick made his first career start and turned in a career-high eight tackles, five solo, including one for a loss and a pass break-up...Cornerback Jordan Wright made five tackles in the first half before being called for a targeting penalty and was ejected for the remainder of the game... Defensive tackle Jevon Banks, in his Husky debut, turned in two tackles and recorded the season's first sack...R-Freshman Cam Chadwick got his first start at corner and had two tackles and a pass break-up...Defensive tackle Dal'Mont Gourdine made a career-best seven tackles...Safety D'Mon Brinson made a career-high six tackles...Linebacker Langston Hardy had a career high four stops and one for a loss...Safety Rante Jones, who was forced to sit the first half last Saturday due to a targeting penalty in the second half of last season's last game at UMass, will have to do the same this week against Merrimack. Jones was called for targeting and ejected in the second half at Maryland.

**New Faces in Storrs...** The 2024 version of the UConn football team will have plenty of new faces as the coaching staff spent the offseason overhauling the roster to blend a mix of talented returning veterans with a wealth of transfers and incoming freshmen. The roster has 51 new players who entered the program since the end of last season. UConn added 28 new players through the transfer portal.

New to the Coaching Staff... Head Coach Jim Mora enters his third season at the helm in 2024 and will have a new offensive and defensive coordinator as well as a new quarterbacks coach on his staff this season. Gordon Sammis, who has been the team's offensive line coach the last two seasons, will continue in that role this fall but add offensive coordinator duties to his responsibilities. Assistant coach Matt Brock joined the Huskies last spring as the team's new defensive coordinator. Brock comes to Storrs after four seasons at Mississippi State including last season as the defensive coordinator. Also coming on board last spring was Brad Robbins as the new quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator. Robbins spent 2023 at Tennessee Tech as the pass game coordinator and wide receivers coach. Coach Mora also brought on staff Tyson Brown as the team's new Director of Football Strength and Conditioning. Like coach Brock, Brown also comes from Mississippi State where he lead the Bulldogs strength and conditioning program since 2020.

**Preseason Watch Lists...** UConn senior offensive tackle Chase Lundt leads a pack of Huskies on preseason watch lists. Lundt was selected to the 2025 Reese's Senior Bowl and the 2025 East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 list. He is joined on the East-West list by teammates Valentin Senn and Jalani Stafford.

Senior linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown was named to the 2024 Polynesian College Football Player of the Year Award watch list announced by the Polynesian Football Hall of Fame. The Award is presented annually to the most outstanding college football player of Polynesian ancestry that epitomizes great ability and integrity. The Watch List is composed of 96 players from 37 different FBS schools. Faumuina-Brown heads into his senior season for the Huskies after moving into a starting role on the UConn defense last fall. Playing in

all in all 12 games, he finished third on the defense in tackles making 61 stops, 32 solo, with four tackles for a loss. He also recorded his first career sack and had an interception on the season.

**Bookend Tackles...** Offensive coordinator Gordon Sammis has put together one of the Huskies' strongest units the last two seasons in the offensive line and will have a pair of returning starter bookend tackles to lead the way in left tackle Valentin Senn and right tackle Chase Lundt. Lundt has played and started 35 games at right tackle for UConn while Senn has started every game at left tackle the last two seasons and has appeared in 29 games for the Huskies since transferring in from Colorado prior to the 2021 season. The duo helped anchor a unit that led the Huskies to a final ranking of 33rd in the nation in rushing offense in 2022, averaging 191.0 yards per game. In the passing game, the UConn offensive line was 29th in the NCAA in sacks allowed, allowing just 1.38 per game in 2022 and followed that up last season by improving to ninth in the country allowing just 12 sacks total (1.00 pg) on the season.

Senior and versatile lineman Christopher Fortin will be in the mix at guard and center but can play any position along the line. R-junior Ben Murawski and transfers, r-junior Tank Green (Charlotte), Wes Hoeh (Syracuse) and Jayden Bass (Syracuse) bring added depth.

Edwards and Rosa Back in the Backfield... The Huskies have a pair of returners in the backfield to use in the running game in Connecticut natives, junior Victor Rosa and r-sophomore Cam Edwards. Rosa has seen action in 23 games in his first two seasons in Storrs and has rushed for 1,186 yards and 14 touchdowns during that stretch. For his career he has averaged 4.7 yards per carry. As a freshman, he led the team with 11 rushing touchdowns.

Edwards was thrust into a feature role in the backfield last fall. Edwards transition from defensive back to running back as a freshman and then last fall saw action in nine games and went on to lead the Huskies in rushing. He finished with 620 yards and four touchdowns and averaged 5.0 yards per carry. He also caught 15 passes for 132 yards and a score.

Added Depth at Running Back... UConn also injected some experience into the running back room with the addition of transfers, junior Mel Brown from Gardner Webb and r-freshman Durell Robinson from Charlotte. Brown played in 19 games at Gardner Webb, running for 870 yards and 10 touchdowns. Also, a receiving threat as well, Brown caught 17 passes for 260 yards and 4 touchdowns. Robinson had four games at Charlotte before an injury cut his season short. He rushed 40 times for 166 yards and a score.

**Building Depth at WR...** The Husky receiving corps saw an infusion of talent through the transfer portal to pair with returner Brett Buckman who is the team's top returning receiving threat. Buckman played in all 12 games, starting 11 last fall after transferring in from Delaware before the season. He posted a career season, catching 46 balls for 488 yards with a pair of scores.

Grad student TJ Sheffield comes to UConn with a year to play after a four-year career at Purdue. He caught 118 passes in 46 games at Purdue for 1,209 yards and 11 touchdowns. R-senior Ezeriah Anderson also has one season to play after coming in from Campbell and Iowa

State. Anderson played 19 games the past two season for the Camels and caught 64 passes for 882 yards and six touchdowns. R-junior Jasaiah Gathings transfers from Akron where last season he caught 55 passes in 12 games for 575 yards and a score. R-junior Skylar Bell came to UConn last spring out of Wisconsin. Bell is coming off a 2023 where he caught 38 passes for 296 yards and a score for the Badgers. R-Freshman Shamar Porter comes to Storrs from Kentucky where he redshirted last season. Prior to starting his college career, he chose Kentucky over Georgia, Tennessee and Ole Miss as a four-star wide receiver by 247 Sports and On3.com.

Experience on the D-Line... Senior defensive tackles Dal'Mont Gourdine and Jelani Stafford along with r-junior end Pryce Yates are all coming off strong seasons and are back to lead the Husky defensive front this fall. Stafford, named to the 2025 Shrine Bowl 1000 watch list, has played in every game the last two seasons since transferring in from Youngstown State. He posted 40 tackles last season, 28 solo, and had eight tackles for a loss and two fumble recoveries. Stafford was a dual threat last season as well, serving as the Huskies' short yardage back on offense. He had 15 carries and scored six touchdowns in goal line situations.

Gourdine has played in all 37 games over the last three seasons at tackle and is coming off a 28 tackles campaign last fall. He posted a career-high 5.5 tackles for loss including 3.0 sacks as well. Yates has also been a constant on the defensive line, playing 25 games the last two seasons. He posted 42 tackles last fall and led the team with 14.0 tackles for loss with 4.5 sacks. The Huskies have depth up front with the additions of transfers, grad students Jayden Simon (Tulsa) and Jack Burton (Furman), and r-senior Jevon Banks (Kansas State).

New Look Specials... The UConn special team units will have almost a completely new look this fall with a new punter, place kicker and long snapper. Grad student place kicker Chris Freeman comes in from Indiana, where he handled kick-off duties in 2022 and took over field goals in 2023. He was 10-for-14 on field goal attempts with a long of 50 yards last fall. Junior punter Connor Stutz transferred in after two seasons at Sacramento State where he played in 26 games and average 45.6 yards per kick.

*UConn Draft Pick...* Two-time All-American offensive guard Christian Haynes was selected in the third round of the 2024 NFL Draft this past April by the Seattle Seahawks with the 81st overall pick. Haynes became the 14th Husky in program history to be selected in the first three rounds of the draft and the first since the 2022 draft. He is the 44th UConn player to be selected in the NFL Draft and the 30th Husky taken during the program's FBS era (2002-present). Haynes is the first draft pick since defensive tackle Travis Jones was taken by the Baltimore Ravens in the third round of the 2022 draft. He is the eighth UConn offensive linemen in program history to be selected in the NFL Draft and the first since the 2020 draft when the New York Giants took offensive tackle Matt Peart in the third round.

The UConn football team lost their 2024 season opener at Maryland, 50-7, in front of 35,421 at SECU Stadium. Maryland quarterback Billy Edwards Jr. threw for 311 yards and two scored and led an offensive attack that piled up 629 yards in the win.

UConn r-junior wide out Skyler Bell hauled in five passes for a career-high141 yards in his first game for the Huskies. R-Senior receiver TJ Sheffield caught two passes for 32 yards and UConn's only touchdown in the loss.

The Huskies (0-1) were held to just 88 yards rushing and 11 first downs on Saturday while Maryland ran for 248 yards and threw for 381 to kick-off the season.

The Terps (1-0) running game was led by backs Roman Hemby and Nolan Ray led the rushing attack with 126 yards combined and two scores. Edwards finished the day 20-of-27 while his back-up Cameron Edge came in and went five-of-six for 57 yards and a score.

Maryland came out of the gates with a touchdown on their first two drives of the afternoon. The Terps took the opening kick-off and needed eight plays to cover 75 yards with Edwards Jr. finding Tai Felton for an 18-yard score. After a deep punt put the Terps back on their eight-yard line, the offense made it 14-0 seven plays later as Ray broke free for a 48-yard scoring run. Maryland's offense rang up 131 yards rushing in the first quarter.

UConn's defense held Maryland to three field goals the rest of the first half as the Terps went to the locker room up 23-0. Maryland made it 30-0 on their first possession of the second half as Hemby scored from four yards out to cap a 78-yard drive for his only score

R-Freshman quarterback Nick Evers made his first collegiate start and finished sixof-17 for 73 yards with an interception before being forced from the game in the third quarter due to injury. Back-up Joe Fagnano came in and led the Huskies on their only scoring drive late in the third. Fagnano found Sheffield up the right sideline for a 27-yard hook-up and Sheffield's first touchdown as a Husky. Fagnano finished out the game 8-of-16 for 149 yards, a touchdown and an interception.

The Terps left no doubt as on their first play of the ensuing drive Edwards Jr. connected with Felton who broke free and flew up his own sideline for a 75-yard score. Felton finished the game with seven catches for 178 yards.
