QUICK HITS---

- The UConn Huskies are back on the road Saturday night as the face the Duke Blue Devils on ESPN+ and ACCNX. Kick-off is schedule for 6:02 pm.
- The Huskies and Blue Devils met last season at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field, a 41-7 win for the then No. 19 nationally ranked Blue Devils. UConn's last trip to Brooks Field at Wallace Wade Stadium took place during the 2007 season and resulted with the Huskies coming away with a 45-14 win. UConn and Duke announced last season they have agreed to four future match-ups, in East Hartford in 2025 and 2029 and back in Durham in 2026 and 2030.
- The Huskies head into this weekend's match-up coming off a blow out 63-17 win over Merrimack in their home opener last Saturday. The Huskies went to back-up quarterback Joe Fagnano and the senior signal caller led the UConn offense to a record setting day. The Huskies had a school record 624 yards of offense while also tying the school FBS record for points in a game. The 46-point win is the largest margin of victory since a 45-10 win over Memphis in 2013.
- Saturday night's game will be the Huskies last road game until a November 9th trip to UAB. UConn will kick-off a six-game homestand starting with next Saturday night's match-up with Florida Atlantic. The win over Merrimack improved the Huskies to 15-6 in home openers at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. For the first time since the 2016 season, the Huskies will play seven home games in a season.
- UConn Head Coach Mora returns for his third season leading the Huskies. Mora guided UConn to a 6-7 record in year one and brought the Huskies back to a postseason bowl game for the first time since the 2015 season. After a 1-4 start to the season, Mora led UConn to a 5-2 run through the rest of the regular season to become bowl eligible. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.
- THE STADIUM: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and begin their 21st season of play at their off-campus home in 2024. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 71-58 at Rentschler Field and a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

Last Meeting vs. Duke

Sep. 23, 2023 -- #18 Duke 41 - UConn 7 -- Rentschler Field The No. 18 nationally ranked Duke Blue Devils turned in a strong defensive performance to the tune of a 41-7 win over the UConn Huskies in front of 29,033 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. The Huskies were shut out for three quarters and finished with 203 yards of total offense including just 89 yards rushing. The Duke defense added a score in the win as defensive lineman De-Wayne Carter returned a fumble 26 yards for a touchdown in the third quarter. Duke's Jordan Waters ran the ball just seven times for 18 yards but had a pair of touchdowns in the win. The Blue Devils shut the Huskies down offensively in the first half, holding UConn to just 32 total yards and four first downs into the half. Duke put up 20 points in the second quarter with sophomore placekicker Todd Pelino opening the second with a 50-yard field goal and closing it with a 40-yarder to make it 27-0 at the break. Carter made it 34-0 at 7:13 in the third, scooping up a Jalen Mitchell fumble and rumbling in from 26-yards out. Junior quarterback Riley Leonard finished 23-of-34 for 248 yards and a touchdown and finished as Duke's leading rusher with four carries for 30 yards and a touchdown in the win. UConn ended the shutout bid late in the fourth quarter as r-junior quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson capped off a 10-play, 83-yard drive with a twoyard score, producing the 41-7 final. Roberson was 13-of-28 for 114 vards and was sacked twice. Sophomore Victor Rosa carried the ball 14 times for 68 yards in the loss.

Scouting the Blue Devils...

The Duke Blue Devils are off to a 2-0 start to their season after a double overtime 26-20 win on the road at Northwestern last weekend. The Blue Devils host the Huskies and then head to Middle Tennessee next week before jumping into ACC play. R-So. quarterback Maalik Murphy, who transferred in from Texas for this season, has completed 50-of-79 for 533 yards and five touchdowns through two games. Murphy threw for three scores including the second overtime gamewinner to lead the Blue Devils over Northwestern. Preseason All-ACC wideout Jordan Moore has caught 18 passes for 233 yards and a score in the first two games. He is averaging 12.9 yards per catch. In the backfield, grad student transfer Star Thomas has seen the bulk of carries early, running for 81 yards on 30 carries. Transfer linebacker Alex Howard has 21 tackles including 4.5 for a loss and a sack to lead the defense.

UConn vs. the ACC ...

The Huskies are 7-25 all-time against the ACC. UConn has three games against teams from the conference this season with trips to Duke and Syracuse and a home game with Wake Forest. The Huskies went 0-3 against the league last season with home loses to NC State and Duke and a loss at Boston College. UConn is 2-1 against Duke, 2-2 against Virginia and 1-2 against Wake Forrest. The Huskies are 1-4 against Boston College since the Eagles joined the league in 2005 and 0-3 vs. Syracuse since the Orange jumped to the ACC in 2013. UConn has also faced Clemson (0-1), Georgia Tech (0-3), North Carolina (0-3) and NC State (0-4). The Huskies were 1-3 against Maryland when the Terrapins were a member of the conference through 2014. The Huskies have also faced Louisville, Miami, Pitt, SMU and Virginia Tech in their history but prior to those teams joining the ACC. The Huskies have never faced Cal, Florida State or Stanford.





Head Coach Jim Mora

Head Coach Jim Mora will begin his third season on the UConn sidelines in 2024. Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896.

In his first season in Storrs in 2022, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschlar Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

Following the 2023 season, the Huskies saw the program's first two-time All-American during the FBS era in offensive guard Christian

Haynes, who garnered AP and The Sporting News All-American honors for the second consecutive season. Haynes also became the first NFL Draft pick under Mora when he was selected in the third round by the Seattle Seahawks.

"Jim is a proven winner, a man of integrity, and he possesses the experience and the energy to lead our football program back to success," said David Benedict, UConn Director of Athletics, upon Mora's hiring. "Jim is excited and undaunted by this challenge, and we both know that this program has great potential. I'm certain that, under Coach Mora's leadership, UConn football will once again realize that potential."

Mora, 60, brings 31 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 10 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

"I am excited to have the opportunity to become the head football coach at the University of Connecticut," Mora said. "UConn possesses a nationally-recognized academic and athletics brand and I am thrilled to become a member of the community that makes up UConn Nation. This program is loaded with potential."

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego, Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota.

Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

Record Setting Day... The UConn Huskies improved to 21-2 against FCS opponents thanks to their record setting performance in a 63-17 win over Merrimack last weekend. The Huskies scored 35 points on just 16 plays in the first quarter of Saturday's win, and finished the first half with 56 points, both new FBS school records. The 63 total points tied the school FBS mark for points in a game (vs. Kent State - 2002). UConn's offense piled up 624 yards to set a new school record for total offense.

QB Fagnano Sets New Record as Well... Back-up quarterback Joe Fagnano got the starting nod with injured started Nick Evers out of action. Fagnano answered by leading the offense to the tune of 328 yards passing and five touchdown throws. Fagnano completed 13-of-19 passes had touchdown throws of 50, 60, 39, 44 and 12 yards while 10 different UConn receivers caught passes in the win. Fagnano also ran for 38 yards and a touchdown. His five TD throws tied the school record set by Dan Orlovsky who did it three times during his career.

Bell Hits 100 Again... In his first two games as a Husky, r-junior wideout Skyler Bell has gone over the 100-yard mark receiving. In the season opener, Bell hauled in five passes for 141 yards marking the first 100-yard game by a UConn receiver since the 2021 season when Keelan Marion had 102 yards at Vanderbilt. On Saturday, Bell caught two passes for 105 yards including his first UConn touchdown, a 60-yard hook-up with Fagnano. For Bell, it was his second and third career 100-yard games, his first coming in 2022 at Wisconsin when he had four catches for 108 yards and two scores against New Mexico State. Through two games, Bell has seven catches for 246 yards, ranking 12th nationally in yards and yards per game.

Offensive Notes from Merrimack... WR Skyler Bell hit the 100-yard receiving mark in back-to-back games, the first Husky to do so since the 2016 season when Noel Thomas had five-straight 100-yard games...Fagnano's five-touchdown throws matched his career, set previously against Liberty in the 2019 season when he played at Maine...Fagnano threw for 328 yards, becoming the first UConn quarterback to throw for over 300 yards since David Pindell (319) did it against Rhode Island in 2018...Tight End Alex Honig, who missed most of last season with a knee injury, caught his first career passes as a Husky and scored his first career touchdown...R-Freshman wideout Shamar Porter caught his first career passes and his first career touchdown while r-senior Ezeriah Anderson hauled in his first touchdown as a Husky...Running back Durrell Robinson just missed a 100-yard day, running for 94 yards on 10 carriers and his first touchdown for UConn...RBs Victor Rosa and Cam Edwards also found the end zone with Edwards also hauling in a touchdown pass.

Defensive Notes from Merrimack... The UConn defense held Merrimack to 279 yards of offense while picking up four sacks and 10.0 tackles of a loss...R-Senior linebacker Jayden McDonald finished with a team-high eight tackles...R-freshman end Brandon Kelly recorded a career-high five tackles including his first career sack...Cornerback Jordan Wright had four tackles and his first career sack...Linebackers Tui Faumuina-Brown and Julien Simon had the other UConn sacks.

Special Teams Notes... A pair of Huskies are among the national leaders in kickoff and punt returns in Mel Brown and TJ Sheffield...Brown has returned four kicks in the first two games for 126 yards, an average of 31.5 yards per return to rank sixth among NCAA leaders...Sheffield has nine punt returns on his ledger for 77 yards, an 8.6 average per return, ranking 39th.

Offensive Line Led by Bookend Tackles... Offensive coordinator Gordon Sammis has put together one of the Huskies' strongest units the last two seasons in the offensive line and will have a pair of returning starter bookend tackles to lead the way in left tackle Valentin Senn and right tackle Chase Lundt. The duo helped anchor a unit that led the Huskies to a final ranking of 33rd in the nation in rushing offense in 2022, averaging 191.0 yards per game. In the passing game, the UConn offensive line was 29th in the NCAA in sacks allowed, allowing just 1.38 per game in 2022 and followed that up last season by improving to ninth in the country allowing just 12 sacks total (1.00 pg) on the season. The two tackles along with center Wes Hoeh, a transfer from Syracuse, and guards senior Chris Fortin and r-junior Ben Murawski make up this year's unit and through two games the unit has not allowed a sack.

First Career Start for Evers... R-Sophomore Nick Evers was named the Huskies' starter at the end of summer camp and made his first collegiate start in the loss at Maryland. Evers joined the Huskies after spring, transferring in from Wisconsin. He finished the game

six-of-17 for 73 yards and an interception before leaving the game in the third quarter with an injury. R-senior Joe Fagnano came in and led the lone UConn scoring drive. He finished eight-of-16 for 149 yards and a score. Fagnano won the starting quarterback job out of camp last season but saw his season come to an end in game two with a shoulder injury. Fagnano transferred in to UConn at the start of last season from Maine, where he was coming off a season in which he threw for 2,231 yards and 15 touchdowns. Fagnano was named to the 2024 Comeback Player of the Year watch list this preseason.

Preseason Watch Lists... UConn senior offensive tackle Chase Lundt leads a pack of Huskies on preseason watch lists. Lundt was selected to the 2025 Reese's Senior Bowl and the 2025 East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 list. He is joined on the East-West list by teammates Valentin Senn and Jalani Stafford.

Senior linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown was named to the 2024 Polynesian College Football Player of the Year Award watch list announced by the Polynesian Football Hall of Fame. The Award is presented annually to the most outstanding college football player of Polynesian ancestry that epitomizes great ability and integrity. The Watch List is composed of 96 players from 37 different FBS schools. Faumuina-Brown heads into his senior season for the Huskies after moving into a starting role on the UConn defense last fall. Playing in all in all 12 games, he finished third on the defense in tackles making 61 stops, 32 solo, with four tackles for a loss. He also recorded his first career sack and had an interception on the season.

Edwards and Rosa Back in the Backfield... The Huskies have a pair of returners in the backfield to use in the running game in Connecticut natives, junior Victor Rosa and r-sophomore Cam Edwards. Rosa has seen action in 23 games in his first two seasons in Storrs and has rushed for 1,186 yards and 14 touchdowns during that stretch. For his career he has averaged 4.7 yards per carry. As a freshman, he led the team with 11 rushing touchdowns.

Edwards was thrust into a feature role in the backfield last fall. Edwards transition from defensive back to running back as a freshman and then last fall saw action in nine games and went on to lead the Huskies in rushing. He finished with 620 yards and four touchdowns and averaged 5.0 yards per carry. He also caught 15 passes for 132 yards and a score.

New Faces in Storrs... The 2024 version of the UConn football team will have plenty of new faces as the coaching staff spent the offseason overhauling the roster to blend a mix of talented returning veterans with a wealth of transfers and incoming freshmen. The roster has 51 new players who entered the program since the end of last season. UConn added 28 new players through the transfer portal.

Added Depth at Running Back... UConn also injected some experience into the running back room with the addition of transfers, junior Mel Brown from Gardner Webb and r-freshman Durell Robinson from Charlotte. Brown played in 19 games at Gardner Webb, running for 870 yards and 10 touchdowns. Also, a receiving threat as well, Brown caught 17 passes for 260 yards and 4 touchdowns. Robinson had four games at Charlotte before an injury cut his season short. He rushed 40 times for 166 yards and a score.

Building Depth at WR... The Husky receiving corps saw an infusion of talent through the transfer portal to pair with returner Brett Buckman who is the team's top returning receiving threat. Buckman played in all 12 games, starting 11 last fall after transferring in from Delaware before the season. He posted a career season, catching 46 balls for 488 yards with a pair of scores.

Grad student TJ Sheffield comes to UConn with a year to play after a four-year career at Purdue. He caught 118 passes in 46 games at Purdue for 1,209 yards and 11 touchdowns. R-senior Ezeriah Anderson also has one season to play after coming in from Campbell and Iowa State. Anderson played 19 games the past two season for the Camels and caught 64 passes for 882 yards and six touchdowns. R-junior Jasaiah Gathings transfers from Akron where last season he caught 55 passes in 12 games for 575 yards and a score. R-junior Skylar Bell came to UConn last spring out of Wisconsin. Bell is coming off a 2023 where he caught 38 passes for 296 yards and a score for the Badgers. R-Freshman Shamar Porter comes to Storrs from Kentucky where he redshirted last season. Prior to starting his college career, he chose Kentucky over Georgia, Tennessee and Ole Miss as a four-star wide receiver by 247 Sports and On3.com.

New to the Coaching Staff... Head Coach Jim Mora enters his third season at the helm in 2024 and will have a new offensive and defensive coordinator as well as a new quarterbacks coach on his staff this season. Gordon Sammis, who has been the team's offensive line coach the last two seasons, will continue in that role this fall but add offensive coordinator duties to his responsibilities. Assistant coach Matt Brock joined the Huskies last spring as the team's new defensive coordinator. Brock comes to Storrs after four seasons at Mississippi State including last season as the defensive coordinator. Also coming on board last spring was Brad Robbins as the new quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator. Robbins spent 2023 at Tennessee Tech as the pass game coordinator and wide receivers coach. Coach Mora also brought on staff Tyson Brown as the team's new Director of Football Strength and Conditioning. Like coach Brock, Brown also comes from Mississippi State where he lead the Bulldogs strength and conditioning program since 2020.

UConn Draft Pick... Two-time All-American offensive guard Christian Haynes was selected in the third round of the 2024 NFL Draft this past April by the Seattle Seahawks with the 81st overall pick. Haynes became the 14th Husky in program history to be selected in the first three rounds of the draft and the first since the 2022 draft. He is the 44th UConn player to be selected in the NFL Draft and the 30th Husky taken during the program's FBS era (2002-present). Haynes is the first draft pick since defensive tackle Travis Jones was taken by the Baltimore Ravens in the third round of the 2022 draft. He is the eighth UConn offensive linemen in program history to be selected in the NFL Draft and the first since the 2020 draft when the New York Giants took offensive tackle Matt Peart in the third round.

The UConn football team lost their 2024 season opener at Maryland, 50-7, in front of 35,421 at SECU Stadium. Maryland quarterback Billy Edwards Jr. threw for 311 yards and two scored and led an offensive attack that piled up 629 yards in the win.

UConn r-junior wide out Skyler Bell hauled in five passes for a career-high141 yards in his first game for the Huskies. R-Senior receiver TJ Sheffield caught two passes for 32 yards and UConn's only touchdown in the loss.

The Huskies (0-1) were held to just 88 yards rushing and 11 first downs on Saturday while Maryland ran for 248 yards and threw for 381 to kick-off the season.

The Terps (1-0) running game was led by backs Roman Hemby and Nolan Ray led the rushing attack with 126 yards combined and two scores. Edwards finished the day 20-of-27 while his back-up Cameron Edge came in and went five-of-six for 57 yards and a score.

Maryland came out of the gates with a touchdown on their first two drives of the afternoon. The Terps took the opening kick-off and needed eight plays to cover 75 yards with Edwards Jr. finding Tai Felton for an 18-yard score. After a deep punt put the Terps back on their eight-yard line, the offense made it 14-0 seven plays later as Ray broke free for a 48-yard scoring run. Maryland's offense rang up 131 yards rushing in the first quarter.

UConn's defense held Maryland to three field goals the rest of the first half as the Terps went to the locker room up 23-0. Maryland made it 30-0 on their first possession of the second half as Hemby scored from four yards out to cap a 78-yard drive for his only score

R-Freshman quarterback Nick Evers made his first collegiate start and finished six-of-17 for 73 yards with an interception before being forced from the game in the third quarter due to injury. Back-up Joe Fagnano came in and led the Huskies on their only scoring drive late in the third. Fagnano found Sheffield up the right sideline for a 27-yard hook-up and Sheffield's first touchdown as a Husky. Fagnano finished out the game 8-of-16 for 149 yards, a touchdown and an interception.

The Terps left no doubt as on their first play of the ensuing drive Edwards Jr. connected with Felton who broke free and flew up his own sideline for a 75-yard score. Felton finished the game with seven catches for 178 yards.

The UConn Huskies tied the school FBS record for points in a game in a 63-17 win over visiting Merrimack College in front of 32,351 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in the 2024 home opener.

Senior quarterback Joe Fagnano led the UConn offense with 328 yards passing and five touchdown throws, tying the school record set by Dan Orlovsky who did it three times during his career. Fagnano finished the day completing 13-of-19 passes and had touchdown throws of 50, 60, 39, 44 and 12 yards while 10 different UConn receivers caught passes in the win.

Fagnano and the Huskies piled up 624 total yards of offense on Saturday also setting a new UConn school record. The Huskies 63 points matches the FBS record for points in a game, set against Kent State on November 9, 2002. The 46-point win is the largest margin of victory since a 45-10 win over Memphis in 2013.

UConn (1-1) came flying out of the gates and scored 35 points in the first quarter on 16 total plays, setting a new school FBS record for points in a quarter (28 4x - last vs URI 9/15/18). The Huskies finished the first half with 56 points and 486 yards of offense with Fagnano completing 10-of-15 passes for 298 yards and four scores. UConn's 56 points at the half sets a new FBS school record for points in a half (49 vs Kent State, 11/9/02).

R-Junior Skyler Bell caught two passes and had 105 yards receiving including a 60-yard touchdown catch, his first as a Husky. Bell hit the century mark receiving for the second-straight game.

R-Junior tight end Alex Honig caught three passes, including his first career touchdown, while r-senior Ezeriah Anderson and r-freshman Shamar Porter each caught a pair of passes and scored their first touchdowns as Huskies.

On the ground, UConn piled up 278 yards rushing and were led by r-freshman Durrell Robinson who finished with 94 yards on 10 carries and a score. Junior Mel Brown ran for 87 yards on a team-high 14 carries.

Fagnano added 38 yards rushing and a score to his offensive totals for the day while junior Victor Rosa and r-sophomore Cam Edwards each found the end zone as well; Edwards twice, once through the air and another on the ground..

The UConn defense held Merrimack (0-2) to 279 yards of offense while picking up four sacks and 10.0 tackles of a loss. R-Senior linebacker Jayden McDonald finished with a team-high eight tackles.

Merrimack's Jermaine Corbett ran for 103 yards and a touchdown in the loss. Junior back-up quarterback Justin Lewis came in and was 6-of-6 for 103 yards and a touchdown.
