

QUICK HITS---

- The UConn Huskies come off their bye week to play host to the Wake Forest Demon Deacons of the ACC on Saturday afternoon at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. Kick-off is slated for 12 noon on CBS Sports Network.
- This week's game marks the fourth meeting in the series between UConn and Wake Forest and the first since the 2007 season. The Demon Deacons own a 2-1 edge in the all-time series and have won two-straight. The last meeting came in the 2007 Meineke Car Care Bowl in Charlotte, NC, a 24-10 win for Wake Forest. The Demon Deacons also won in their only previous trip to The Rent, a 24-13 win in 2006. Saturday also marks UConn's third meeting with an ACC opponent this season, having lost at Duke and a trip up to Syracuse still to come. The Huskies have dropped five-straight to ACC teams with their last win coming at home in 2022 against Boston College.
- UConn rode into the bye week at 4-2 thanks to a thrilling 29-20 win over Temple. The UConn defense came up with a fourth and goal stop with three seconds left in the game, capped by cornerback Jordan Wright scooping a fumble and returning it 96 yards for a touchdown to put the final stamp on a 29-20 win. The Huskies are 4-2 to start a season for the first time since the 2009 season.
- The Huskies are 4-0 at home for the first time since the 2010 season when the Huskies were a perfect 6-0 at The Rent that season. The Huskies have outscored opponents 187-54 and are averaging 46.8 points per game on their home turf. The Huskies have won five-straight at home dating back to last season.
- UConn Head Coach Mora returns for his third season leading the Huskies. Mora guided UConn to a 6-7 record in year one and brought the Huskies back to a postseason bowl game for the first time since the 2015 season. After a 1-4 start to the season, Mora led UConn to a 5-2 run through the rest of the regular season to become bowl eligible. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.
- THE STADIUM: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and begin their 21st season of play at their off-campus home in 2024. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 74-58 at Rentschler Field and a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

Last Meeting vs. Wake Forest

Dec. 29, 2007 -- Wake Forest 24 - UConn 10 -- Charlotte, NC, Meineke Car Care Bowl

Wake Forest quarterback Riley Skinner was 29 of 38 in the air for 268 yards and a touchdown to lead the Demon Deacons to a 24-10 victory over the UConn in the 2007 Meineke Car Care Bowl before a crowd of 53,126 at Bank of America Stadium. The two halves were mirror images of each other as UConn shutout Wake Forest in the first half and the Demon Deacons held the Huskies scoreless in the second. Connecticut, the 2007 BIG EAST Conference champions, finishes the year with a 9-4 record. Husky junior quarterback Tyler Lorenzen was 13-of-26 for 98 yards. UConn was led in rushing by sophomore Donald Brown with 13 carries for 72 yards. UConn led 10-0 at the half, but Wake Forest scored two third quarter touchdowns to take a 14-10 lead and never looked back. Wake Forest senior wide receiver Kenny Moore was name the game's Most Valuable Player as he made 11 receptions for 112 yards. Josh Adams was the leading rusher for the Deacons with 66 yards on 19 carries.

Scouting the Demon Deacons...

Wake Forest comes to Connecticut off a 49-14 loss at home to the No. 10 nationally ranked Clemson Tigers last weekend. This will be the Demon Deacons final non-conference match-up this fall as they return to ACC play next weekend at Stanford. Wake Forest is 1-2 in the ACC this season. The Demon Deacons have had success throwing the football this year behind r-senior Hank Bachmeier, who ranks sixth in the nation in completions per game (20.7), ninth in passing yards (1439), eighth in passing yards per game (239.8) and TD passes (9). Bachmeier has spread the ball around, with wideouts Taylor Morin (29), Deuce Alexander (21) and Horatio Fields (20) all with 20 or more catches. WR Donavon Greene has big play capability with 16 catches for 271 yards and two scores; averaging 16.94 yards per catch. On the ground, junior Desmond Claiborne has carried it 99 times for 524 yards and six touchdowns. He averages 5.3 yards per carry, eighth nationally. His 87.3 yards per game ranks seventh. Defensively, junior defensive back Nick Andersen is the team's top tackler with 69 stops, first nationally at 11.5 tackles per game. He also has 34 solo tackles, ranking first in the NCAA at 5.7 per game.

UConn vs. the ACC ...

The Huskies are 7-26 all-time against the ACC. UConn has three games against teams from the conference this season with a loss at Duke, today's match-up with Wake Forest and an upcoming trip to Syracuse still to come. The Huskies went 0-3 against the league last season with home loses to NC State and Duke and a loss at Boston College. UConn is 2-2 against Duke, 2-2 against Virginia and 1-2 against Wake Forrest. The Huskies are 1-4 against Boston College since the Eagles joined the league in 2005 and 0-3 vs. Syracuse since the Orange jumped to the ACC in 2013. UConn has also faced Clemson (0-1), Georgia Tech (0-3), North Carolina (0-3) and NC State (0-4). The Huskies were 1-3 against Maryland when the Terrapins were a member of the conference through 2014. The Huskies have also faced Louisville, Miami, Pitt, SMU and Virginia Tech in their history but prior to those teams joining the ACC. The Huskies have never faced Cal, Florida State or Stanford.





Head Coach Jim Mora

Head Coach Jim Mora will begin his third season on the UConn sidelines in 2024. Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896.

In his first season in Storrs in 2022, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschlar Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

Following the 2023 season, the Huskies saw the program's first twotime All-American during the FBS era in offensive guard Christian

Haynes, who garnered AP and The Sporting News All-American honors for the second consecutive season. Haynes also became the first NFL Draft pick under Mora when he was selected in the third round by the Seattle Seahawks.

"Jim is a proven winner, a man of integrity, and he possesses the experience and the energy to lead our football program back to success," said David Benedict, UConn Director of Athletics, upon Mora's hiring. "Jim is excited and undaunted by this challenge, and we both know that this program has great potential. I'm certain that, under Coach Mora's leadership, UConn football will once again realize that potential."

Mora, 60, brings 31 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 10 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

"I am excited to have the opportunity to become the head football coach at the University of Connecticut," Mora said. "UConn possesses a nationally-recognized academic and athletics brand and I am thrilled to become a member of the community that makes up UConn Nation. This program is loaded with potential."

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego, Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota.

Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

Offensive Notes from Temple... The UConn offense ran a season-high 82 plays in the win over Temple...For the first time in four games, the Huskies were held to under 100 yards rushing (99) while averaging just 2.4 yards per rush, a season-low, in the win over the Owls...UConn also averaged a season-low 4.5 yards per play and was just three-of-15 on third down, also a season-low mark... The Huskies turned it over a season-high three times in the game...WR TJ Sheffield had a career-day, catching nine passes for 141 yards, both career-best, and had a 58-yard TD catch, the longest catch of his career...TE Louis Hansen hauled in a career-best four passes...QB Joe Fagnano completed 24 of 41 passes, both season-high marks for a UConn quarterback this fall.

Defensive Notes from Temple... CB Jordan Wright scored his first career defensive TD on the 96-yard scoop and score on the game's final play, completing a goal-line stand and sealing the win over Temple...The Huskies matched their season-high with 10.0 tackles for a loss in the win... LB Jayden McDonald led the way with 2.5 stops for a loss, a season-high for a Husky this season. McDonald posted a season-high 14 tackles and got his first sack of the season...Fellow LB Tui Faumuina-Brown posted 2.0 tackles for loss, a new career-high...DE Jack Barton got his first sack as a Husky in the win...The Huskies have had a sack in five of the six games this season...LB Langston Hardy came up with eight tackles, a new career-high...DT Jelani Stafford matched his career-high with season-best seven tackles...Safety Malik Dixon-Williams got his first interception on the season, and the fourth of his career. The defense as a whole has gotten a pick in each of the last four games.

Special Teams Notes from Temple... Place kicker Chris Freeman made all three of his field goal attempts, hitting from 43, 24 and 35 yards. After starting 0-of-3 on the season, Freeman has now made nine-straight. Freeman also had three touchbacks on his six kickoffs. On the season he is averaging 64.2 yards on kickoffs with 24 touchbacks on 41 kickoffs...Punter Connor Stutz punted six times against Temple. He posted a season-best 47.0 average per kick and unleashed his long of the season with a 66-yard boot. On the season, Stutz has put eight kicks inside opponents 20-yard line and has nine punts of 50+ yards.

Huskies Named to Joe Moore Award Mid-season Honor Roll... The Joe Moore Award for the Most Outstanding Offensive Line Unit in college football since 2015, announced the twenty-two members of its 2024 Mid-season Honor Roll with the UConn offensive line earning a spot among the programs honored. The Huskies offensive line is among a group of o-lines from Alabama, Army, Clemson, Iowa, Kansas State, Louisiana, LSU, Miami, Michigan, Navy, Ohio State, Oregon, Penn State, Rutgers, SMU, Tennessee, Texas, Texas Tech, UNLV, Western Michigan, and West Virginia to make the mid-point honor roll. The UConn offensive line, tackles Chase Lundt and Valentin Senn, guards Christopher Fortin and Ben Murawski and center Wes Hoeh, are coached by offensive coordinator Gordon Sammis, in his third season with the program. Through six games in 2024, the Huskies only allow pressure on 22.7% of drop backs, the sixteenth best rate in the nation. UConn has been sacked on just 2.2% of drop backs this season, ninth best rate in the nation. In the running game, the Huskies O-line paves the way for an offense that is averaging 220.3 yards per game.

UConn in ESPN FPI... After UConn's bye week, the Huskies are now 73rd (-1.1) in the ESPN's College Football Power Index (FPI). The Football Power Index (FPI) is a measure of team strength that is meant to be the best predictor of a team's performance going forward for the rest of the season. FPI represents how many points above or below average a team is. Projected results are based on 20,000 simulations of the rest of the season using FPI, results to date, and the remaining schedule. Ratings and projections update daily. FPI data from seasons prior to 2019 may not be complete.

Bell Among NCAA Leading WRs... R-Junior wideout Skyler Bell is off to a blazing start to his UConn career through six games. Bell has hauled in 22 passes for 508 yards and four touchdowns and has three 100-yard games to his credit. Bell is averaging 23.09 yards per catch and 84.7 yards per game. He currently ranks fourth in the NCAA in yards per catch, 37th in receiving yards, 34th in receiving yards per game and 36th in touchdowns. In the season opener, Bell hauled in five passes for 141 yards at Maryland, marking the first 100-yard game by a UConn receiver since the 2021 season when Keelan Marion had 102 yards at Vanderbilt. Against Merrimack, Bell caught two passes for 105 yards including his first UConn touchdown, and became the first UConn receiver to go over 100 yards in back-to-back games since Hergy Mayala did during the 2017 season. For Bell, he now has four career 100-yard games, his first coming in 2022 at Wisconsin when he had four catches for 108 yards and two scores against New Mexico State

Husky Rankings... The UConn offense is ranked 29th in the nation in total offense, averaging 449.7 yards per game...The running game is churning out 220.3 yards per game, ranked 15th in the country...The Huskies passing attack is helped by the fact the offensive line has allowed just four sacks in six games, ranking ninth in the nation at 0.67 sacks allowed per game...The Huskies rank 24th in scoring offense (35.8)...The Huskies are 41st in fewest penalties (34) and 44th in penalties per game (5.67)...On defense, UConn is ranked third in third down conversion percentage, holding opponents to .256 percent and 20th in fourth down conversion percentage at .375 percent...The Husky defense is 17th in the country in the red zone (.722), eighth in defensive TDs (2), 21st in first down defense (100)...In the passing game, UConn ranks 19th in pass yards allowed (191.5)...LB Jayden

McDonald is 39th in tackles per game (8.3)...On special teams, the UConn kick-off return ranks 23rd averaging 24.29 yards per return...On punt returns, receiver TJ Sheffield ranks 25th averaging 9.5 yards per return...Punter Connor Stutz is 31st in punting average (43.5)...Place kicker Chris Freeman ranks 27th in FG per game (1.50), 33rd in points (53) and 32nd in points per game (8.8) points.

Fagnano Great in Relief Once Again... Quarterback Joe Fagnano made his second start of the season in the win over Temple. Fagnano has played in all six games. He has thrown for 999 yards and 11 touchdowns this season, completing 58.2 percent (57-98) of his passes. His 11 touchdown throws ranks 34th in the nation. His 174.7 passing efficiency is eighth and his 17.53 yards per completion ranks first.

Deep Backfield... The Huskies have a three-headed beast leading the ground game this season. R-junior Durell Robinson leads the team with 423 yards on 55 carries, ranking 62nd nationally in yards and 64th in yards per game (70.2). He is averaging 7.7 yards per carry. Cam Edwards has 320 yards and averages 5.0 yards per rush while Mel Brown has 315 yards and a 5.1 per carry average. Robinson and Brown both went for 156 yards each in the win over Florida Atlantic.

More Records Fall against Buffalo... R-Junior wide receiver Skyler Bell set a new school FBS record with three touchdown catches in the win. Grad student Chris Freeman tied the school record and UConn FBS record with four field goal makes on Saturday. The offense posted 95 points over the last two games, the most in program history in back-to-back games against FBS opponents

Record Running Day at the Rent... UConn's rushing attack ran wild in a 48-14 win over Florida Atlantic. The Huskies plowed their way to a school FBS record 421 yards, which also marked the second most rushing total in program history (437 – vs UMass, 1956). The Huskies ran the ball 66 times in the, also setting a new FBS record for rushing attempts in a game. It tied for the fourth most attempts in a game all-time.

Record Setting Day vs. Merrimack... The UConn Huskies improved to 21-2 against FCS opponents thanks to their record setting performance in a 63-17 win over Merrimack. The Huskies scored 35 points on just 16 plays in the first quarter of Saturday's win, and finished the first half with 56 points, both new FBS school records. The 63 total points tied the school FBS mark for points in a game (vs. Kent State - 2002). UConn's offense piled up 624 yards to set a new school record for total offense.

QB Fagnano Sets New Record as Well... Back-up quarterback Joe Fagnano got the starting nod against Merrimack with injured started Nick Evers out of action. Fagnano answered by leading the offense to the tune of 328 yards passing and five touchdown throws. Fagnano completed 13-of-19 passes had touchdown throws of 50, 60, 39, 44 and 12 yards while 10 different UConn receivers caught passes in the win. Fagnano also ran for 38 yards and a touchdown. His five TD throws tied the school record set by Dan Orlovsky who did it three times during his career.

First Career Start for Evers... R-Sophomore Nick Evers was named the Huskies' starter at the end of summer camp and made his first collegiate start in the loss at Maryland. Evers joined the Huskies after spring, transferring in from Wisconsin. He finished the game six-of-17 for 73 yards and an interception before leaving the game in the third quarter with an injury. R-senior Joe Fagnano came in and led the lone UConn scoring drive. He finished eight-of-16 for 149 yards and a score. Fagnano won the starting quarterback job out of camp last season but saw his season come to an end in game two with a shoulder injury. Fagnano transferred in to UConn at the start of last season from Maine, where he was coming off a season in which he threw for 2,231 yards and 15 touchdowns. Fagnano was named to the 2024 Comeback Player of the Year watch list this preseason.

Preseason Watch Lists... UConn senior offensive tackle Chase Lundt leads a pack of Huskies on preseason watch lists. Lundt was selected to the 2025 Reese's Senior Bowl and the 2025 East-West Shrine Bowl 1000 list. He is joined on the East-West list by teammates Valentin Senn and Jalani Staf-

ford.

Senior linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown was named to the 2024 Polynesian College Football Player of the Year Award watch list announced by the Polynesian Football Hall of Fame. The Award is presented annually to the most outstanding college football player of Polynesian ancestry that epitomizes great ability and integrity. The Watch List is composed of 96 players from 37 different FBS schools. Faumuina-Brown heads into his senior season for the Huskies after moving into a starting role on the UConn defense last fall. Playing in all in all 12 games, he finished third on the defense in tackles making 61 stops, 32 solo, with four tackles for a loss. He also recorded his first career sack and had an interception on the season.

New Faces in Storrs... The 2024 version of the UConn football team will have plenty of new faces as the coaching staff spent the offseason overhauling the roster to blend a mix of talented returning veterans with a wealth of transfers and incoming freshmen. The roster has 51 new players who entered the program since the end of last season. UConn added 28 new players through the transfer portal.

New to the Coaching Staff... Head Coach Jim Mora enters his third season at the helm in 2024 and will have a new offensive and defensive coordinator as well as a new quarterbacks coach on his staff this season. Gordon Sammis, who has been the team's offensive line coach the last two seasons, will continue in that role this fall but add offensive coordinator duties to his responsibilities. Assistant coach Matt Brock joined the Huskies last spring as the team's new defensive coordinator. Brock comes to Storrs after four seasons at Mississippi State including last season as the defensive coordinator. Also coming on board last spring was Brad Robbins as the new quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator. Robbins spent 2023 at Tennessee Tech as the pass game coordinator and wide receivers coach. Coach Mora also brought on staff Tyson Brown as the team's new Director of Football Strength and Conditioning. Like coach Brock, Brown also comes from Mississippi State where he lead the Bulldogs strength and conditioning program since 2020.

UConn Draft Pick... Two-time All-American offensive guard Christian Haynes was selected in the third round of the 2024 NFL Draft this past April by the Seattle Seahawks with the 81st overall pick. Haynes became the 14th Husky in program history to be selected in the first three rounds of the draft and the first since the 2022 draft. He is the 44th UConn player to be selected in the NFL Draft and the 30th Husky taken during the program's FBS era (2002-present). Haynes is the first draft pick since defensive tackle Travis Jones was taken by the Baltimore Ravens in the third round of the 2022 draft. He is the eighth UConn offensive linemen in program history to be selected in the NFL Draft and the first since the 2020 draft when the New York Giants took offensive tackle Matt Peart in the third round.

The UConn football team lost their 2024 season opener at Maryland, 50-7, in front of 35,421 at SECU Stadium. Maryland quarterback Billy Edwards Jr. threw for 311 yards and two scored and led an offensive attack that piled up 629 yards in the win.

UConn r-junior wide out Skyler Bell hauled in five passes for a career-high141 yards in his first game for the Huskies. R-Senior receiver TJ Sheffield caught two passes for 32 yards and UConn's only touchdown in the loss.

The Huskies (0-1) were held to just 88 yards rushing and 11 first downs on Saturday while Maryland ran for 248 yards and threw for 381 to kick-off the season.

The Terps (1-0) running game was led by backs Roman Hemby and Nolan Ray led the rushing attack with 126 yards combined and two scores. Edwards finished the day 20-of-27 while his back-up Cameron Edge came in and went five-of-six for 57 yards and a score.

Maryland came out of the gates with a touchdown on their first two drives of the afternoon. The Terps took the opening kick-off and needed eight plays to cover 75 yards with Edwards Jr. finding Tai Felton for an 18-yard score. After a deep punt put the Terps back on their eight-yard line, the offense made it 14-0 seven plays later as Ray broke free for a 48-yard scoring run. Maryland's offense rang up 131 yards rushing in the first quarter.

UConn's defense held Maryland to three field goals the rest of the first half as the Terps went to the locker room up 23-0. Maryland made it 30-0 on their first possession of the second half as Hemby scored from four yards out to cap a 78-yard drive for his only score

R-Freshman quarterback Nick Evers made his first collegiate start and finished sixof-17 for 73 yards with an interception before being forced from the game in the third quarter due to injury. Back-up Joe Fagnano came in and led the Huskies on their only scoring drive late in the third. Fagnano found Sheffield up the right sideline for a 27-yard hook-up and Sheffield's first touchdown as a Husky. Fagnano finished out the game 8-of-16 for 149 yards, a touchdown and an interception.

The Terps left no doubt as on their first play of the ensuing drive Edwards Jr. connected with Felton who broke free and flew up his own sideline for a 75-yard score. Felton finished the game with seven catches for 178 yards.

The UConn Huskies tied the school FBS record for points in a game in a 63-17 win over visiting Merrimack College in front of 32,351 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in the 2024 home opener.

Senior quarterback Joe Fagnano led the UConn offense with 328 yards passing and five touchdown throws, tying the school record set by Dan Orlovsky who did it three times during his career. Fagnano finished the day completing 13-of-19 passes and had touchdown throws of 50, 60, 39, 44 and 12 yards while 10 different UConn receivers caught passes in the win.

Fagnano and the Huskies piled up 624 total yards of offense on Saturday also setting a new UConn school record. The Huskies 63 points matches the FBS record for points in a game, set against Kent State on November 9, 2002. The 46-point win is the largest margin of victory since a 45-10 win over Memphis in 2013.

UConn (1-1) came flying out of the gates and scored 35 points in the first quarter on 16 total plays, setting a new school FBS record for points in a quarter (28 4x - last vs URI 9/15/18). The Huskies finished the first half with 56 points and 486 yards of offense with Fagnano completing 10-of-15 passes for 298 yards and four scores. UConn's 56 points at the half sets a new FBS school record for points in a half (49 vs Kent State, 11/9/02).

R-Junior Skyler Bell caught two passes and had 105 yards receiving including a 60-yard touchdown catch, his first as a Husky. Bell hit the century mark receiving for the second-straight game.

R-Junior tight end Alex Honig caught three passes, including his first career touchdown, while r-senior Ezeriah Anderson and r-freshman Shamar Porter each caught a pair of passes and scored their first touchdowns as Huskies.

On the ground, UConn piled up 278 yards rushing and were led by r-freshman Durrell Robinson who finished with 94 yards on 10 carries and a score. Junior Mel Brown ran for 87 yards on a team-high 14 carries.

Fagnano added 38 yards rushing and a score to his offensive totals for the day while junior Victor Rosa and r-sophomore Cam Edwards each found the end zone as well; Edwards twice, once through the air and another on the ground..

The UConn defense held Merrimack (0-2) to 279 yards of offense while picking up four sacks and 10.0 tackles of a loss. R-Senior linebacker Jayden McDonald finished with a team-high eight tackles.

Merrimack's Jermaine Corbett ran for 103 yards and a touchdown in the loss. Junior back-up quarterback Justin Lewis came in and was 6-of-6 for 103 yards and a touchdown.

The UConn Huskies got 106 yards rushing and a touchdown from r-sophomore Cam Edwards but saw their second half lead erased in the fourth quarter as the Duke Blue Devils came away with a 26-21 win in front of 20,174 at Brooks Field at Wallace Wade Stadium.

Duke, who moves to 3-0 with the win, erased a 21-17 UConn lead in the fourth quarter with a Todde Pelino field goal and quarterback Malik Murphy's third touchdown throw of the night en route to the win. Murphy finished the night 28-for-43 for 267 yards and three touchdowns and an interception.

For UConn (1-2), Edwards rumbled to his third career 100-yard game needing 21 carries to hit the century mark while adding a 26-yard catch to his stat line. R-Sophomore Nick Evers was back under center to lead the UConn offense and threw his first career touchdown. Evers finished the night 15-of-29 for 135 yards and also ran it 10 times for 60 yards.

The Blue Devils got on the board on their first drive on the night as Murphy led them on a nineplay, 92-yard drive he capped with a four-yard scoring strike to Jordan Moore for a 7-0 lead. An Evers fumble set up another Duke score as Pelino hit from 53-yards out for a 10-0 lead at 12:10 in the second quarter. After forcing a three-and-out, Moore capped another scoring drive with his second touchdown throw of the night, this time finding a streaking Eli Pancol up the left sidelines for a 36-yard score and a 17-0 lead with 8:27 to go in the half.

The UConn defense pulled the Huskies back into the game, forcing their first turnover of the season and turning it into six. Linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown broke up a Muphy pass and fellow linebacker Langston Hardy picked it off and rumbled 64 yards for the score.

The Huskies owned the third quarter, putting two scoring drives together while outgaining Duke 124-43 in yards to take a 21-17 lead. Forcing a three-and-out on Duke's first possession, Evers orchestrated an eight-play drive with Edwards capping it off with a one-yard plunge to pull within 17-14. Another three-and-out gave Evers and the offense the ball back and the Huskies new QB finished off a 75-yard drive finding his tight end Alex Honig in the front corner of the end zone for a 21-17 lead at 8:21 of the third.

Duke pulled within 21-20 on the first play of the fourth quarter as Pelino hit his second field goal of the night, this time from 47 yards out to cap a 10-play drive that only covered a total of 13 yards. The Blue Devils created their second turnover on the next UConn drive, an Evers interception, and Murphy took them down the field in seven plays, capping the 56-yard drive to go back in front with a 20-yard TD throw to Que'Sean Brown on a third down play. The two-point try failed putting Duke up 26-21 with 11:52 left in the fourth.

The Huskies had a chance to cut into the lead but a 48-yard field goal chance with 5:42 left went wide right and the Blue Devils would take over and never give UConn the ball back. The Duke offense put together a 12-play drive highlighted by a Star Thomas 21-yard run where he could of scored but gave himself up at the UConn three-yard line, letting the Blue Devils kneel out the clock for the win.

Thomas ran for 122 yards on 22 carries while Brown caught all 11 passes thrown his way for 87 yards and a score for Duke. The Blue Devils finished with 409 yards of total offense.

UConn was led defensively by Faumuina-Brown who had 12 tackles and a pair of pass breakups. Fellow linebacker Jayden McDonald had 11 tackles.

The UConn offense ran for a FBS school record 421 yards as the Huskies posted a 48-14 win over Florida Atlantic in front of 20,144 fans at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies (2-2) ran wild as r-freshman Durell Robinson and junior Mel Brown both went for 156 yards to pace the rushing attack. It marked the first time since the 2019 season two Huskies ran for over 100-yards (vs UMass 10/26/2019). The 421 yards was the second most rushing total in program history (437 – vs UMass, 1956).

For Robinson, it was his first career 100-yard rushing game, carrying the ball 16 times on the night and finding the end zone twice. For Brown, he topped his career-high, needing 21 carries to hit 156 yards, while marking his third career 100-yard effort

UConn r-sophomore Nick Evers finished with a career-high 78 yards rushing on 18 carries and two touchdowns. Evers completed nine-of-14 for 88 yards and a touchdown. He led the UConn offense to 542 total yards on 81 plays while picking up 32 first downs, the first time getting 30 or more first downs since the 2018 season (vs. SMU – 34). The Huskies also did not punt on Saturday night, a first since a game at Syracuse during the 2004 season.

The Huskies ran their way to a 17-0 lead at the half, pounding the ball at the FAU defense to the tune of 31 rushes for 169 yards while holding the football for 20:36. The Huskies ran 42 total plays to 20 for the Owls in the first half.

After forcing a three-and-out on the game's first possession, the UConn offense put the first points on the board as grad student kicker Chris Freeman converted on his first field goal of the season, a 34-yarder, to cap a 10-play drive. Freeman snapped a 0-for-3 streak to start the season with the make.

The Huskies orchestrated a pair of 12-play drives in the second quarter to put a pair of touch-downs on the board. Evers converted on a second-and-goal try at 11:32, finding junior Mel Brown out of the backfield for a 10-0 lead. Evers then led UConn's longest scoring drive of the season, pacing the offense 91-yards, running on 10 of the 12 plays, capped by an eight-yard burst up the middle by Robinson at 1:50 for a 17-0 lead.

The UConn running attack picked right up to open the second as Evers ran in his first career rushing touchdown, a three-yard plunge, to cap of a 14-play drive which featured 12 runs to cover the 75 yards. UConn got their first turnover of the night on the Owls next possession as linebacker Jayden McDonald picked-off a tipped pass to set up the Huskies on FAU 23-yard line. Freeman drilled home his second field goal of the night at 5:57, a 35-yard attempt, to extend the lead to 27-0.

The Owls ended UConn's bid at a shutout with 2:17 left in the third as CJ Campbell Jr. ran in from three yards out. UConn's Evers and Robinson opened the fourth quarter each posting their second scores of the night to push the UConn lead to 41-7 with just under 12 to play. Senior quarterback Joe Fagnano came on and threw a 33-yard touchdown to r-freshman Shamar Porter for the Huskies final score.

UConn's defense gave up a season-low 250 total yards in the win, just 87 yards through the air. Senior linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown led the defense with nine tackles.

UConn wideout Skyler Bell hauled in six passes for 153 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Huskies to a 47-3 win over the University at Buffalo Saturday afternoon in front of 20,347 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The UConn (3-2) offense had another big performance, running for 257 yards and passing for 280, while the defense was equally impressive, allowing a season-low three points and 198 total yards in the win. The Huskies have lit up the scoreboard to the tune of 95 points over the last two games, the most in program history in back-to-back games against FBS opponents and the most since 2009 (89 – 33 at Notre Dame; 56 vs Syracuse). UConn also improved to 3-0 at home thus far this season and have outscored opponents 158-34.

For Bell, it was a career-high for receiving yards and touchdown catches and marked his third game this season hitting the 100-yard mark. His three touchdown grabs is a new school FBS record and marks the first Husky to catch three touchdowns in a game since the 1996 season (Dak Newton 3 vs. Villanova). He has four career 100-yard receiving games.

Defensively, the Huskies recorded three sacks and grabbed an interception while holding Buffalo to just 12 first downs, 1-of-14 on third down while forcing eight three-and-outs. Linebacker Langston Hardy had a pair of sacks and fellow linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown had the other as well as six tackles. Safety Rante Jones got his first interception of the season and the third of his career.

The Huskies built a 23-0 lead late into the second quarter as kicker Chris Freeman made three of his four field goals in the first half. Running back Cam Edwards scored the game's first touchdown, a 43-yard tackle off the left end for a 10-0 lead after the first.

UConn's starter Nick Evers was forced from the game in the second quarter with an injury leaving back-up Nick Fagnano to take over play-calling duties. Fagnano finished 11-of-19 for 217 yards and three touchdowns in relief, all three to Bell.

Fagnano and Bell found pay dirt in the second quarter on a 40-yard catch-and-run to make it 23-0. Buffalo (3-2) the first half a seven-play drive that was capped by a 47-yard Upton Bellenfant field goal as time expired, their only points of the day.

Fagnano hit Bell for two third quarter scores, the first a 70-yard score, the longest-scoring play by the Huskies this season. The two finished off the trifecta on a 12-yard strike into the endzone to make it 37-3 with 5:33 left in the third.

UConn had a balanced running game with Edwards leading the way 97 yards on 10 carries with a score. Durell Robinson had eight rushes for 73 yards and Mel Brown had 10 carries for 53 yards and a fourth quarter touchdown.

Freeman connected on field goals of 26, 39, 22 and 27 yards, tying the UConn school and FBS record for field goals in a game. His 4-for-4 effort marks the first time a UConn kicker had four makes since Dave Teggart did it at Cincinnati in 2011.

The UConn defense came up with a fourth and goal stop with three seconds left in the game, capped by cornerback Jordan Wright scooping a fumble and returning it 96 yards for a touchdown to put the final stamp on a 29-20 win over Temple in front of 28,921 at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies earn their third-straight victory and improve to 4-2 on the season heading into the bye week. UConn has won four-straight at home, five-straight dating back to last season.

R-Senior TJ Sheffield caught nine passes for 141 yards, both career-highs, with a 58-yard touchdown, the longest catch of his career. R-Fr. Running back Durell Robinson ran for a teamhigh 52 yards and a go-ahead fourth quarter score. Senior quarterback Joe Fagnano finished 24-of-41 for 272 yards a score and two picks.

Temple's Maddux Trujillo made a pair of field goals, including a 60-yarder, the longest field goal ever made at Rentschler Field. Running back Terrez Worthy finished with a game-high 95 yards on 12 carries.

Trujillo's back-to-back third quarter field goals gave the Owls (1-5) a 13-9 lead with 2:43 left in the quarter. Fagnano would hook-up with Sheffield for a short gain but the wideout broke free of a tackle and flew up the right sideline for a 58-yard score to put UConn in front 16-13.

Temple took the lead back early in the fourth quarter, turning a Fagnano interception into a 44-yard drive that ended with quarterback Forrest Brock scampering in from eight yards out for a 20-16 lead with 9:52 left.

Fagnano was able to put together a 10-play scoring drive, keeping the drive alive with one of the biggest plays of the night. Fighting his way out of a sack, the senior quarterback was able to find Brett Buckman all alone up the sidelines for 32 yards on a third-and-10 play that set up the Huskies on the Temple 38. From there, Robinson pounded the ball down to the one before plunging in on the next play for a 23-20 lead with 3:46 left.

Temple took over on their own 25-yard line after the touchback and drove the ball all the way to the UConn one-yard line to set up the late game drama. On second and goal, Antwain Littleton came up just short of the goal line and was then stuffed on third and goal at the one. The Owls let the clock run down to three seconds before using their final time-out on fourth and goal, setting up the final play for the win. Quarterback Tyler Douglas tried to push in over the right tackle but the ball popped loose before he could get anywhere with Wright there to scoop it at the four and fly up the field to seal the win and celebration.

Defensively, linebacker Jayden McDonald had 14 tackles, 2.5 for a loss, with a sack. Fellow linebacker Tui Faumuina-Brown made 11 tackles, two for a loss. Safety Malik Dixon-Williams had nine stops and his first interception of the season.

Kicker Chris Freeman was responsible for all the UConn scoring in the first half, hitting field goals of 43, 24, and 35 yards. Since starting the season 0-for-3, Freeman has nine-straight makes.

Temple's lone score in the first half came off a blocked punt in the endzone, recovered by John Adams.
