

Ohio Football Welcomes Five Student-Athletes to the 2023 Signing Class

ATHENS, Ohio—The Ohio football program added five student-athletes to its 2023 signing class today (Feb. 1), as announced by second-year head coach Tim Albin.

Wide receiver Chase Hendricks (St. Louis, Mo.), defensive end Danny Novickas (Chicago, Ill.), linebacker Brady Sestili (Delaware, Ohio), kicker Gianni Spetic (Chardon, Ohio) and safety DJ Walker (Aliquippa, Pa.). 12 student-athletes signed their National Letters of Intent and two graduate transfers committed to join the Bobcats during the early signing period, putting the 2023 signing class at 19 student-athletes.
