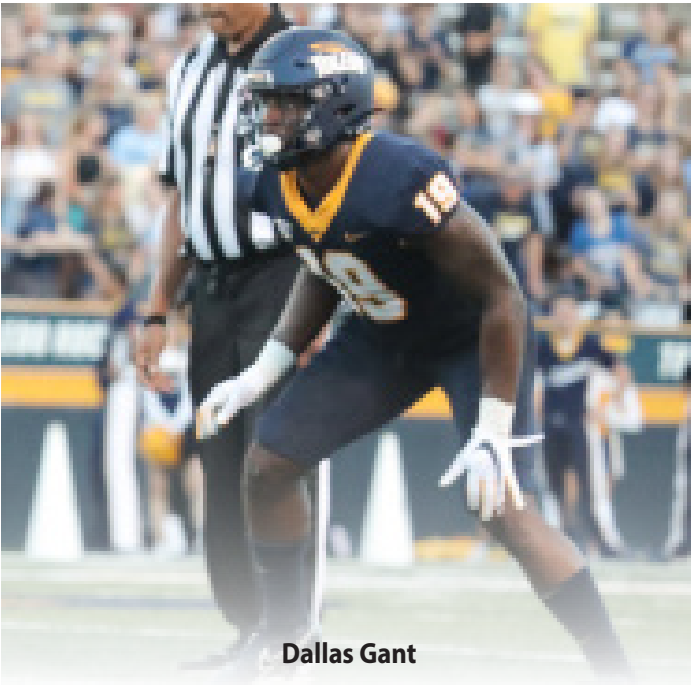

• In addition to Mitchell's heroics, Toledo had a dominating performance on offense. Sophomore quarterback Dequan Finn completed 13-of-19 passes for 167 yards and three touchdowns. Sophomore Jerjuan Newton led the receiving corps with five catches for 89 yards and a career-best two touchdowns.

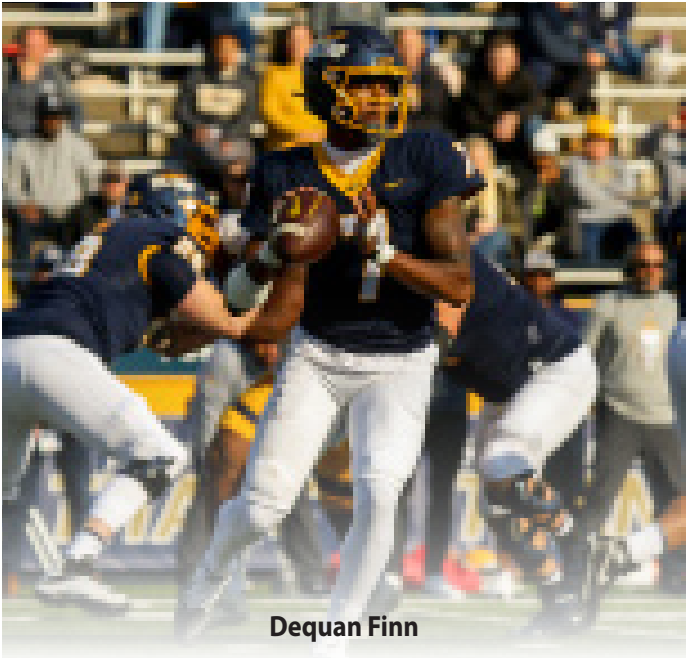

- Quarterback Dequan Finn threw a career-best six touchdown passes to four different receivers to rally Toledo from a 21-point deficit and lead the Rockets to a 52-31 victory over Kent State.

- Finn's six TD passes tied a school record that is shared by Bruce Gradkowski (twice, 2003 and 2004) and Logan Woodside (2017). Finn also rushed for a score, which set a Toledo record for seven touchdowns accounted for in one game.

- Toledo's 21-point comeback ties for the third-largest comeback in school history. The largest was a 24-point turnaround in a 32-31 win over Western Carolina in 1975.

- Toledo trailed 21-0 barely five minutes into the game before Finn and the Rockets began their rally. Finn ran for a 27-yard TD in the first quarter, then threw for touchdown passes of 27, 36 and 39 yards in the second quarter to tie the score at 28-28. In the second half, Finn threw for scores of seven, 41 and eight yards. He also ran for 87 yards on 14 attempts.

- Holding a 10-7 lead in the fourth quarter, Dequan Finn hit DeMeer Blankumsee for a 16-yard touchdown pass with 10:36 left in the game. Toledo's defense then did its job, holding the Bobcats scoreless on their final three drives.

- Toledo's defense, ranked No. 1 in the MAC much of the season, dominated the Bobcats for most of the game, holding Ohio to the fewest points by any team in MAC Championship Game history. Ohio gained 262 yards of total offense, including just 69 yards in the second half. Dallas Gant led Toledo with 10 tackles and Nate Bauer had an interception.

- Finn was named the game's Offensive MVP, Dyontae Johnson (eight tackles, 0.5 TFL) was Defensive MVP, and Jonathon Batzke (46.5 punting average) was the Special Teams MVP.

- It was Toledo's 12th MAC Championship title overall, and fourth triumph in the MAC Championship Game. It was also Head Coach Jason Candle's second MAC title. His Rockets won the title in 2017, his second year as Toledo's head coach.
