JOHN MACKEY AWARD

Nation's Top Tight End

Trey McBride, 2021



Following the 2020 season, which was shortened to just four games due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Trey McBride evaluated his NFL prospects and ultimately decided to return to Colorado State for the 2021 with one goal in mind: to be the best tight end in the country.

Mission accomplished.

During his 2021 campaign, McBride posted one of the greatest seasons by an offensive player in school history and one of the all-time best by a tight end in FBS history. He led all FBS tight ends in receptions (90), yards (1,121), and yards per game (93.4) and became the school's career and single-season leader in both categories among tight ends.

The yardage total was the fifth-most in a single season by an FBS tight end and the most in Mountain West history. Following the season, McBride was named to a bevy of All-American teams including all five of the NCAA-recognized selectors to become the first unanimous All-American in program history and first offensive player in Mountain West history to reach that status.

McBride put a bow on the postseason recognition campaign when he was named the John Mackey Award winner as the nation's top tight end. He received the news from his parents, Kate and Jen McBride, the night before the Home Depot ESPN College Football Awards show when the nation was informed.

On Feb. 23, 2022, McBride officially received his trophy from Jerry Mackey, nephew of John Mackey, at a ceremony in Canvas Stadium as well as at halftime of the Border War men's basketball game.

The NFL confirmed the selection when McBride was selected No. 55 overall by the Arizona Cardinals in the second round of the 2022 NFL Draft.

He was the first tight end selected.

JIM THORPE AWARD

Nation's Top Defensive Back

Greg Myers, 1995



The personification of "student-athlete" and the winner of the 1995 Jim Thorpe Award, Greg Myers claimed as many decorations off the field as he did for his stellar on-field performance.

The first player in WAC history to earn All-WAC honors four times, Myers holds the league record with seven all-conference selections, four as a defensive back and three as a return specialist. A two-time First Team All-American, Myers led the NCAA with 555 punt return yards and three punt return touchdowns. He also set the WAC record with 1,332 career punt return yards, and he posted Colorado State records with three punt return scores and a 15.9-yard average. As a defensive back, he totaled 295 tackles and 15 interceptions. Myers helped guide the Rams to back-to-back WAC titles and Holiday Bowl berths.

A 1995 NFF National Scholar-Athlete, he was also named the Honda Scholar-Athlete of the Year that fall. Myers was named a two-time Academic All-American and a four-time Academic All-WAC honoree. The 1996 Nye Trophy recipient as CSU's most outstanding male athlete in academics, he was named to the NCAA Today's Top VIII. He earned a bachelor's degree in biological sciences in 1996 and a M.D. from the University of Colorado in 2006.

A fifth-round pick in the 1996 NFL Draft, Myers played five seasons with the Cincinnati Bengals and Dallas Cowboys. A 2001 Colorado State University Sports Hall of Fame inductee and a 2012 Colorado Sports Hall of Fame member, Myers was the second Ram to enter the College Football Hall of Fame, following 1981 inductee Thurman McGraw.

Greg Myers' No. 3 jersey is honored for his induction into the College Football Hall of Fame.

Greg Myers remains one of the all-time greatest football players in school history and is the only Ram to have received a major national award. Myers' 1995 Jim Thorpe Award, given to the nation's top defensive back, is the highest individual NCAA award received by any CSU football player. He is a five-time first team All-WAC player and two time first-team All-American and the third consensus All-American in school history. Myers not only helped lead CSU to consecutive WAC championships in 1994 and 1995, he also received academic All-American honors in 1994 and 1995 as well. He returned four punts for touchdowns during his career and is tied with Gary Glick and Bill Kishman with 14 career interceptions all-time.

Myers' success on the field is still one of the finest in school history, but coupled with his amazing success in the classroom places him in a category second-to-none in school history. He is the only Ram football player named to first-team All-America on the field and as an Academic All-American in two consecutive seasons. Drafted by the Cincinnati Bengals in the 5th round of the 1996 draft, he spent four seasons in Cincinnati and one in Dallas before retiring from the NFL. Myers went back to school and is now an anesthesiologist in the Denver area. In 2012 he was inducted into the Colorado Sports Hall of Fame and a month later was selected to the 2012 class of the National Football Foundation College Football Hall of Fame. Myers and Fum McGraw are the only two former CSU football players in the college football hall of fame.

Eddie Hanna (1947-49)

Eddie "Twinkle Toes" Hanna helped lead then-Colorado A&M to its first-ever bowl game, the 1949 Raisin Bowl, before his untimely passing after a game at Colorado College the following season. No player in program history has donned the #21 jersey since.

A trailblazer for race inclusion on Colorado A&M's campus, Hanna was one of three Black Uplayers on the 1948 team and was widely popular in the locker room. Hanna served in the Pacific during World War II and came to Fort Collins after a stint in junior college in his hometown of Dodge City, Kansas. As an example of his popularity, Hanna also hosted a radio show in town and was a frequent contributor to the *Rocky Mountain Collegian*, CSU's student newspaper.

A three-sport star for Colorado A&M, Hanna also played basketball and ran track. Following his untimely death, the Eddie Hanna Memorial Scholarship was created in his honor.

One of the greatest names in school history, there are few things that Thurman "Fum" McGraw did not do during the 40 years he competed in athletics or worked for Colorado State University. McGraw was the third brother to attend Colorado A&M College and a native of Paonia, Colo. Fum excelled in all three sports he participated in during his four years as an Aggie athlete and earned All-American awards in football (1948, 1949), track (discus 1949) and wrestling (1948). He is the only athlete in school history to be named an All-American in three different sports. Also a member of the 1949 Raisin Bowl team, Fum went on to a career in the NFL that spanned five seasons and won two world championships with the Detroit Lions.

After his NFL career, he returned to his alma mater to be an assistant coach in football and wrestling. After a short stint in the NFL as an assistant coach, McGraw was named the school's assistant athletic director in 1965 under Jim Williams. He played an integral part in the construction of Moby Arena and Hughes Stadium before leaving in 1968. In 1976, he returned to CSU as the school's director of athletics where he remained until his retirement in 1986. In 1997, CSU named the new McGraw Athletic Center in his honor. Fum McGraw died in 2000 at the age of 73.
