

# RAINBOW WARRIOR FOOTBALL GAME NOTES

#### **GAME STORYLINES**

- ▶ This week is UH's Homecoming Game. The Warriors have won their last four Homecoming Games and are 40-29-1 all-time. UH has played a Homecoming Game every year since 1949 with the exception of the COVID-shortened 2020 season.
- ▶ This week's match-up with Duquesne is the second meeting between the teams after Hawai'i won the first, 42-21 in 2018 in Honolulu. That game was also UH's Homecoming Game.
- ▶ In the 2018 game, Duquesne led 14-0 to start the game before the Rainbow Warriors scored 35 unanswered led by quarterback Cole McDonald, who threw for 273 yards and five touchdowns.
- ▶ This year's Homecoming Game marks the earliest in school history. Previously the earliest Homecoming Game was Sept. 19, 2019 versus Central Arkansas.
- UH head coach Timmy Chang won all four of his Homecoming Games as the starting quarterback for the Rainbow Warriors.
- ▶ UH won last year's Homecoming Game, 27-24 over nationally ranked Fresno State.
- ▶ UH has won its last 18 games against FCS teams dating back to the 2001 season. Hawai'i's last loss to an FCS opponent was to Portland State in 2000 at Aloha Stadium.
- ▶ UH is coming off a 56-10 loss at fourth-ranked Michigan last Saturday in Ann Arbor, Mich. The Wolverines led 42-0 at the half in a game in which kick-off was delayed one hour due to lightning in the area.
- ▶ The loss dropped UH to 0-3 for the first time since 2013 when the team lost its first 11 games en route to a 1-11 season.
- ▶ The Warriors have been out-scored 168-37 in their first three games this season. UH ranks No. 131 nationally in points allowed per game (56.0 ppg).
- ▶ Duquesne (1-2) won its first game of the season last week after a 34-14 home victory over Thomas More. The Dukes opened the season with road losses at Florida State and Youngstown State.
- ▶ Hawai'i is 0-2 at home this season while Duquesne is 0-2 on the road.

**BOLD CAPS** = Home games played at Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex

- ▶ Duquesne is 1-5 all-time against FBS opponents with its only win at Ohio last season.
- ▶ UH running back Dedrick Parson is the only Rainbow Warrior from the state of Pennsylvania. A native of Philadelphia, Pa., he is a graduate of Imhotep Charter High.
- ▶ UH leads the country in passing attempts (136) but has yet to throw a passing touchdown through three games this season.

#### **NEW HOME STADIUM**

For the next several years, UH will play its home games on-campus at the retrofitted Clarence T.C. Ching Athletics Complex. The stadium seats approximately 9,000 with plans to expand in 2023. Previously, Hawai'i played its home games at Aloha Stadium, which was shuttered at the conclusion of the 2020 season. UH had an all-time record of 211-145-4 in 46 seasons at Aloha Stadium.

#### **INTERVIEW POLICY**

Contact the UH Sports Media Relations Office to arrange player or coach interviews at least 24 hours in advance. Players and coaches will be available for interviews after practice on Tuesday and Wednesday. Every effort will be made to accommodate interview requests but players will not be asked to miss class, study hall, practices, or medical treatment. Players mobile or home numbers will not be released by the Sports Media Relations Office.

#### **MEDICAL POLICY**

The UH Sports Media Relations Office abides by federal law pertaining to the releasing of injury information. We will not disseminate any information about a student-athletes' injury without written consent. The only information given to the media will be if a student-athlete is "probable," "questionable," or "doubtful" to play. However, the student-athlete may release information about his/her injury.

#### **WE ARE THE "RAINBOW WARRIORS"**

In an effort to standardize the school's nicknames, UH officially changed its men's team nickname to "Rainbow Warriors" on July 1, 2013. The school's women's teams are still referred to as "Rainbow Wahine." The word "Wahine" (pronounced wah-HEE-nay) means woman in the Hawaiian language. The rainbow has been part of the nickname since 1923 and Warriors were first adopted in 1974.

#### WHAT'S AN 'OKINA?

What's that punctuation mark in the word Hawai'1? In the Hawaiian language, it's called an 'okina, which translated literally in English means separator. Phonetically it is referred to as a glottal stop, similar to the sound that would be made in the English oh-oh. The 'okina is actually a letter in the Hawaiian language and typed out looks like a backwards, inverted apostrophe. The practice of the UH Sports Media Relations office is to use the 'okina in all Hawaiian words in which they occur.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

#### LAST WEEK VS. MICHIGAN MICH 56, UH 10 — Sept. 10, 2022 Michigan Stadium (110,012); Ann Arbor, Mich.

- ▶ Michigan leads the overall series 4-0 including a 2-0 mark in Ann Arbor.
- ▶ In its two visits to Ann Arbor, UH has been outscored a combined 77-0 in the first half.
- ▶ UH has lost 15 straight road games (including neutral sites) against Power 5 teams.
- ▶ UH played before its second biggest crowd in history (110,012). The top mark was six years ago at the same venue when 110,222 attended UH and Michigan's first-ever meeting in Ann Arbor.
- ▶ UH's 42-point halftime deficit was its largest since 2015 when it trailed 49-0 at Boise State.
- ▶ UH enjoyed its first turnover-free game since the 2020 New Mexico Bowl.
- ▶ UH had just one penalty for 10 yards. The last time UH committed just one penalty was in its 2018 win over Navy.
- ▶ Tylan Hines scored his first career touchdown with a 54-yard rush in the fourth quarter. It was UH's longest play from scrimmage this year.
- ▶ Blessman Ta'ala recorded UH's first sack of the season with a takedown of Cade McNamara in the second quarter. It was the senior's third career
- ▶ John Tuitupou recorded his first career sack with a takedown of McNamara in the third quarter.
- ▶ Virdel Edwards recorded his first career interception with a pick of McNamara in the third quarter. It was UH's second interception of the season.
- ▶ Sophomore Greyson Morgan posted his first career catch with a 21-yard haul in the fourth quarter.
- ▶ Joey Yellen made his second consecutive start as a Rainbow Warrior. He finished 13-of-36 for 113 vards.
- ▶ Three Warriors made their first career starts, two on offense and one on defense: Tamatoa Mokiaoa-Atimalala (WR), Sergio Muasau (LG) and Riley Wilson (LB).

#### **HAWAI'I-DUQUESNE SERIES HISTORY**

 $\blacktriangleright$  The teams have met once with UH winning 42-21 in 2018.

#### LAST MEETING VS. DUQUESNE UH 42, DU 21 — Sept. 22, 2018 Aloha Stadium (26,175); Honolulu, Oʻahu

- ▶ UH spotted the Dukes the first 14 points of the game then scored 35 unanswered points.
- ▶ Quarterback Cole McDonald threw five touchdowns to four different receivers while Dayton Furuta rambled for a career-high 114 yards.
- ▶ The UH defense held Duquesne to just 166 yards of total offense.
- ▶ After falling behind 14-0, UH scored on three straight series to take the lead as McDonald capped each drive with touchdowns passes to John Ursua, JoJo Ward, and Cedric Byrd for a 21-14 halftime lead.

#### **TEAM NOTES**

#### **HOMECOMING HISTORY**

- ▶ This week marks UH's 71st Homecoming Game.
- $\blacktriangleright$  UH has a 40-29-1 (.579) all-time record in Homecoming Games.
- ▶ Duquesne marks the third FCS opponent in the last four Homecoming Games—Duquesne (2018) and Central Arkansas (2019).
- ▶ UH did not have a Homecoming Game in 2020 due to the COVID-shortened season.
- ▶ UH has won its last four Homecoming Games.
- $\,\blacktriangleright\,$  UH's first Homecoming Game was during the 1949 season.
- ▶ UH's largest margin of victory in a Homecoming Game was 58 (68-10 vs. Idaho, 2006) and largest margin of defeat was 75 (75-0 vs. Pacific, 1949).

#### **HAWAI'I VS. THE FCS**

- ▶ UH has won its last 18 games versus Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) teams.
- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors have out-scored their opponents 825-327 during those 18 games with an average margin of victory of 27.7 points.
- ▶ Six of UH's eight largest margins of victory have come against FCS schools, topped by a 65-0 defeat of Prairie View A&M in 1979.
- ▶ UH's last loss against an FCS team was the 2000 season opener to Portland State, 45-20.
- ▶ UH has an FCS team scheduled in each of the next three seasons—Albany (2023), Northern Iowa (2024) and Portland State (2025).

#### **HOME SWEET HOME**

- ► UH has a 4-4 record since moving into Clarence T.C. Ching Complex last season.
- ▶ Hawai'i went 4-2 in its inaugural season of 2021 and are 0-2 this season.
- ▶ UH sold out its first two games (9,346) of the 2022 season.
- ▶ Ching Complex was retrofitted to seat more than 9,000 after UH's former home, Aloha Stadium was shuttered following the 2020 season. Aloha Stadium was home to UH football for 46 seasons.

#### **ROAD WARRIORS**

- ▶ In the last decade (not including 2020 COVID season), UH has played no less than six road games each year, including a program-high seven in 2021.
- ▶ UH will make six road trips this season, including a 8,920-mile trek to Ann Arbor, Mich. The six trips will total 37,080 air miles.
- ▶ The most miles UH travelled in a season was 46,568 in 2016, that included trips to Sydney, Australia (vs. California) and Ann Arbor, Mich., in back-to-back weeks.

#### **ON THE CONTINENT**

- ▶ Since 2016, UH is 14-23 in road/neutral site games and 11-12 in MW road games.
- ▶ In the eight seasons prior, UH went 11-37 in road/neutral site games and 9-23 in Mountain West contests.

#### **UH ON NATIONAL TELEVISION**

- ▶ UH has made 121 all-time appearances on national TV and owns a 29-90-2 (.248) record.
- ▶ Hawai'i is 9-17 on national television dating back to 2019 including an 0-2 mark this season.
- ▶ Hawai'i has dropped seven of its last eight national TV games dating back to last year.
- ▶ UH is scheduled to play two more games on national television in 2022—at San Diego State (CBSSN) and at Fresno State (FSN).

#### **MISCELLANEOUS TEAM NOTES**

- ▶ The UH defense held Michigan to 2-of-6 on third-down conversions. In the last two weeks, UH opponents are just 3-of-13 on third downs.
- ▶ UH out-scored Michigan 3-0 in the third quarter. In UH's first two games the Warriors were out-scored 42-0 in the third.
- ▶ This season, UH has been out-scored 84-20 in the first half and 84-17 in the second half.
- ▶ The last time UH lost its first two home games of the season was 2014 (Washington and Oregon State).
- ▶ UH's season-opening loss to Vanderbilt was its first at home to a Power 5 school since 2014, when it fell to Oregon State. Hawai'i had won its last three home games against Power 5 teams, beating Arizona and Oregon State in 2019 and Colorado in '15.

#### **TROPHY GAMES**

- ▶ UH will play three of its four rivalry trophies in 2022 —Paniolo (vs. Wyoming, Oct. 29), Island Showdown (vs. UNLV, Nov. 19), and Dick Tomey Legacy (at San José State, Nov. 26).
- ▶ The Warriors reclaimed the Paniolo Trophy after a season-ending win over the Cowboys in Laramie
- ▶ UH and Air Force play for the Kuter Trophy, which the Falcons own by virtue of a 2019 win.

#### **HAWAI'I IN THE MOUNTAIN WEST**

- ▶ Hawai'i begins its 11th season in the Mountain West in 2022 and owns a 26-54 (.325) all-time mark—14-27 at home and 12-27 on the road.
- ▶ Since the conference moved to two divisions in 2013, UH is 14-26 against the West and 7-17 versus the Mountain.

#### WATCH OUT

- Five Warriors were named to Watch Lists for three different national awards.
- ▶ PK **Matthew Shipley** was named to the Lou Groza Award watch list while DL **Jonah Kahahawai-Welch** is on the Wuerffel Trophy watch list.
- ▶ Kahahawai-Welch, WR **Jonah Panoke**, DL **Blessman Ta'ala** and OL **Solo Vaipulu** each earned a spot on the Polynesian College Football Player of the Year watch list.

#### **SCHEDULE NOTES**

- ▶ Seven of UH's opponents this season played in bowl games in 2021—Western Kentucky (Boca Raton), Michigan (Orange), San Diego State (Frisco), Nevada (Quick Lane), Wyoming (Famous Idaho Potato), Fresno State (New Mexico), and Utah State (Los Angeles).
- ▶ UH will end the regular season on the road (at San José State) for the second straight year and third time since 2018.

#### **OFFSEASON NOTES**

- ▶ A turbulent offseason saw former head Todd Graham resign and more than 20 players enter the transfer portal. Former record-setting quarterback Timmy Chang was hired as the 25th head coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022.
- Among the list of starters who left the UH program and entered the transfer portal included QB Chevan Cordeiro (San Jose State), LB Darius Muasau (UCLA), DB Khoury Bethley (Arizona State), DL Jonah Laulu, RB Dae Dae Hunter (Liberty), WR Nick Mardner (Cincinnati), CB Cameron Lockridge (Fresno State), and DL Justus Tavai (San Diego State).
- ▶ Cordeiro, Muasau, Hunter, and Tavai all started for their respective teams in their season openers.

#### **NOTES FROM 2021 SEASON**

- ▶ UH concluded the 2021 regular-season with a losing record for the first time since 2017.
- ▶ Hawai'i earned a bowl invitation for a programrecord fourth consecutive year in 2021 and fifth time in the last six seasons.
- ▶ UH would have played in the EasyPost Hawai'i Bowl for the 10th time in program history, however the game was canceled due to COVID concerns within the Warrior program.

#### **OFFENSE NOTES**

#### **QUARTERBACK SHUFFLE**

- ▶ UH has started two different quarterbacks this season. **Brayden Schager** got the start in the season-opener against Vanderbilt while transfer **Joey Yellen** made his first start as a Rainbow Warrior against Western Kentucky and got the start again last week at Michigan.
- ▶ Schager, who made three starts as a true freshman in 2021, played the final three quarters against WKU. The Dallas, Texas native was 18-of-35 for 161 yards against Vandy and 22-of-33 for a career-high 230 yards versus WKU. He did not play against Michigan due to an undisclosed injury.
- ▶ Yellen, who came in relief of Schager in the third quarter of the Vandy game, played the entire first quarter against WKU. The Pitt transfer completed 10-of-20 for 89 yards against Vandy and 4-of-11 for 36 yards versus WKU. He was 13-of-36 for 113 yards against Michigan.
- ▶ Washington State transfer Cammon Cooper also saw action against WKU and rushed two times for two yards and did not attempt a pass. He did not play in either the Vandy or Michigan games.
- ▶ Schager is 2-2 in his career as the starting quarterback which includes a win in his starting debut over nationally ranked Fresno State last season.

#### **'BOW BITES**

- ▶ OL **Micah Vanterpool** has a YouTube channel "Big MiK" with over 700 subscribers and hosts a podcast "Big MiK Takes the Mic".
- ▶ QB **Brayden Schager** and his family founded the HP Buddy Bowl, an annual football event in Texas for special-needs youth. As a 10-year-old, he had the top bracket out of 8.5 million entries in ESPN's 2013 NCAA Tournament basketball pool.
- ▶ WR **Dior Scott** was prominently featured in Netflix's hit series "Last Chance U" which chronicled the 2019 season of Laney College in Oakland, Calif. Scott and former UH WR Jared Smart were teammates on the 2018 Laney squad that captured the CCCAA Championship.
- ▶ DB **Noa Kamana** comes from a footballplaying family as his father Carter (Michigan State), brother Tim (Wyoming), grandfather John (USC), and uncle John Jr. (USC) all played collegiate football.
- ▶ DB Eli **Matagi Thompson** was named after his uncle Eli Thompson who was committed to play at UH but who passed away his senior year of HS. Fire knife dances for his father's luau company "Tihati Productions."
- ▶ WR **Grey Ihu** is named after Earl Grey tea, a favorite of his mom's.
- ▶ LB **Riley Wilson**'s father played for the legendary Ohio State coach Woody Hayes.
- ▶ WR Jonah Panoke and DL John Tuitupou each have three children while LB Logan Taylor has two children
- ▶ Utah transfer OL **Luke Felix-Fualalo** is the tallest Warrior at 6-8 while RB **Robbie Palkal** is the shortest at 5-4.
- ▶ DB **Isaiah Malloe** is the son of former UH assistant and current UCLA assistant Ikaika Malloe. WR **Tamatoa Mokiao-Atimalala**'s brother Titus played at UCF and now plays for UCLA. DB **Von Killin**'s brother Adrian was a running back at UCF and played for Philadelphia Eagles (2020) and Denver Broncos (2021). LS **Solomon Landrum**'s father Mike played tight end for the Atlanta Falcons. DL **Mataio Soli**'s father Junior also played at Arkansas and was a fifth-round draft pick by the San Diego Chargers.
- ► Two players last played football in 2019—RB **Keith Moton III** (Westview HS, Ore.) and DB **JoJo Forest** (Oregon State) while OL **Micah Matearagi** (Virginia) last played in 2018.
- ▶ RB Naszjae "Mojo" Bryant-Lelei changed his last name in the off-season to recognize his Polynesian family connections.
- ▶ LB **Noah Kema** and LB **Demarii Blanks** were JUCO All-Americans at Snow College and College of San Mateo, respectively.
- ▶ WR **Chuuky Hines**'s mother is from Hawai'i and is of Micronesian and Hawaiian descent. His first name Chuuky translates to "mountain" in the Micronesian language of Chuukese.
- ▶ WR **Chad Owens Jr.** and TE **Landon Sims** both don their famous UH football fathers' jersey numbers. Owens wears #2 and Sims wears #30, for his father Travis.

#### **ONE PARSON PARTY**

- **Dedrick Parson** leads the team in rushing with 40 carries for 139 yards and two touchdowns and also has seven receptions for 33 yards.
- ▶ Against Vanderbilt, the Philadelphia, Pa., native had team-highs of 13 carries for 82 yards, including a 37-yard touchdown run that opened the scoring. He also had 15 carries for 29 yards against WKU and 12 rushes for 28 yards at Michigan.
- ▶ In the season-opener, he fumbled twice—both of which were returned for Vandy touchdowns.
- ▶ Parson was the team's second-leading rusher (636 yds.) last season and had a team-leading eight touchdowns and was the third-leading receiver in terms of receptions with 28 catches for 279 yards and another score.
- ▶ Career-highs of 25 rushes for 161 yards and three TDs against NM State last season (Oct. 23). Tallied 115 yards receiving vs. Utah State and scored his first receiving touchdown.

#### **SPREADING IT AROUND**

- ▶ UH is tied for No. 5 nationally with 15 different players with at least one reception this season. Penn State leads the nation with 17 different players followed by Arkansas State, Georgia, Michigan, and NC State (16).
- ▶ In UH's loss to Western Kentucky, 11 different players had at least one reception.

#### **O-LINE EXPERIENCE**

- ▶ Entering the 2022 season, UH's offensive line unit was among the most experienced in the country, ranking sixth nationally in number of starts returning with 109.
- ▶ Ilm Manning has started 50 of 52 career games and earned all-Mountain West honorable mention honors in 2021.
- ▶ **Solo Vaipulu** is in his fifth year with the program and has the second-most career starts (40). **Micah Vanterpool** has 19 career starts.

#### **MORE OFFENSIVE NOTES**

- ▶ UH threw five interceptions against Western Kentucky, the most since throwing five in the 2010 Hawai'i Bowl versus Tulsa.
- ▶ UH committed eight turnovers in its first two games but did not commit one against Michigan.
- $\blacktriangleright\,$  Since 2000, UH is 73-10 when generating 500+ yards of total offense.

# **DEFENSE NOTES**

#### **THE GODFATHER**

- ▶ Linebacker **Penei Pavihi** enters his sixth season in the program having appeared in 50 career games, with 32 starts.
- ▶ The native of American Samoa has been a part of three bowl squads and 32 career victories.
- ▶ Team's leading returning tackler with 47 (28 solo) last season also leads the team this season with 16 tackles (10 solo).
- ▶ In his career, has 171 total tackles, 15 tacklesfor-loss, four sacks, one interception, three fumble recoveries, and one forced fumble.

#### IRON MAN

- ▶ Defensive lineman **Blessman Ta'ala** has not missed a single game in four seasons at UH.
- ▶ An all-Mountain West honorable mention selection in back-to-back seasons, he has played in 54 straight games, starting 41 of them at nose tackle.
- ▶ The Aua, American Samoa native has 105 total tackles, 15.5 tackles-for-loss, 3.0 sacks. and two blocked punts in his career, which began in 2018.

#### **SPECIAL TEAMS NOTES**

#### **ROCKET SHIP**

- ▶ **Matthew Shipley** is in his third season as the team's starting placekicker.
- ▶ The Liberty Hill, Texas native has converted 29-of-38 career field goal attempts and 71-of-71 PAT attempts.
- ► Has a streak of 14 consecutive field goals made from 40-yards and under.
- ▶ Starting punter for the second straight season and has an average of 40.0 yards on 20 punts.
- ▶ Last season was 18-of-21 in field goals which were the most by a UH kicker in a single-season since Tyler Hadden in 2014 (18).
- ▶ Among 20 semifinalists for the Lou Groza Award as the nation's best placekicker and UH's first semifinalist since Jason Elam in 1992. He is also on the preseason watch list this year.

#### **BIG LEG**

- ▶ Sophomore **Kyler Halvorsen**, who finished ninth in the nation in kickoff average (64.0 yards) last season, has averaged 63.0 yards on 10 kickoffs this season with five touchbacks.
- ▶ Last season, he had touchbacks on more than half of his kickoffs (40-of-72).
- ▶ Over his career, he has 45 touchbacks and four kicks out of bounds.

#### **MISCELLANEOUS NOTES**

#### WE ARE THE "BRADDAHHOOD"

- ▶ The "Braddahhood" movement began as an organic, team-unifying slogan created by the players to show solidarity amid an offseason of controversy.
- ▶ WR **Jonah Panoke** was one of the leaders of the movement which has since taken over as the team's motto and endorsed by head coach **Timmy Chang**, whose alma mater Saint Louis School, uses the term "The Brotherhood." Panoke is also a Saint Louis School alum.

#### **CAPTAINS**

▶ Four players were voted captains for the 2022 season: center **Eliki Tanuvasa**, running back **Dedrick Parson**, linebacker **Penei Pavihi**, and defensive lineman **Blessman Ta'ala**.

#### \*\*\*\* STAR WARRIORS

- ▶ This year's roster includes several 4-star athletes, all of whom transferred into the Rainbow Warrior program.
- ▶ Among those include Washington State transfer QB **Cammon Cooper** (247Sports, Rivals), Pitt

- ▶ Four former walk-ons have started this season including OL Eliki Tanuvasa, DB Leonard Lee, DL John Tuitupou, and OL Stephan Bernal-Wendt.
- ▶ In addition, others who joined as walk-ons and received scholarships include QB Jake Farrell, DB Nalu Emerson, and DB Noa Kamana.

#### **SCHOOL HOUSE SHUFFLE**

- ▶ This offseason, UH raided the transfer portal welcoming 17 FBS transfers and two FCS transfers.
- ▶ Among the FBS transfers, 16 are from Power 5 schools—McKenzie Barnes (Arizona), Cammon Cooper (Washington State), Steele Dubar (Colorado), Virdel Edwards II (Iowa State), Andrew Faoliu (Oregon), Luke Felix-Fualalo (Utah), JoJo Forest (Oregon State), Malik Hausman (Arizona), Wynden Hoʻohuli (Nebraska), Devyn King (Maryland), Solomon Landrum (Mississippi), Kaulana Makaula (USC), Micah Mariteragi (Virginia), Meki Pei (Washington), Mataio Soli (Arkansas), and Joey Yellen (Pittsburgh).
- ▶ Other transfers for 2022 include **Anthony Sagapolutele** (UNLV), **Jordan Murray** (Missouri State), and **Jojo Falo** (Cal Poly).
- ▶ In total, UH has 20 FBS transfers and eight FCS transfers on its roster.

#### **ALL IN THE FAMILY**

- ▶ The 2022 squad features six second-generation Rainbow Warriors—Wynden Hoʻohuli (Watson, 2000-05), Kila Kamakawiwoʻole (Kila, 2002-05); Chad Owens, Jr. (Chad Sr., 2001-04), Landon Sims (Travis, 1989-92), Ethan Spencer (Sean), and Matagi Thompson (Afatia, 1998-2000).
- ▶ Three others have older brothers who once suited up for UH—Andrew Choi (Zeno), Sergio Muasau (Darius), and Kamuela Borden (brothers Kawika & Noah). Borden's sister Anika also competed for UH's track and field team.

#### **DIVERSITY U**

- ▶ One of the most diverse teams in the country, UH has players from 18 states, encompassing five time zones, and five countries.
- ▶ Forty percent of the 117-man roster hail from Hawai'i (47) while California (23) and Texas (12) combined make up almost a third. In addition, five players each are from Arizona and Florida.

TIMMY CHANG Head Coach; 1st Season Overall Record: 0-3 (1)

Record at UH: 0-3 (1)

Former record-setting quarterback Timmy Chang was hired as the University of Hawai'i's 25th head football coach in program history on Jan. 22, 2022.

Chang spent the last five seasons as

the wide receivers and tight ends coach at Nevada, before recently following former Wolf Pack head coach Jay Norvell at Colorado State. During his five seasons at Nevada, Chang helped direct one of the most potent offensive attacks on the West Coast while the Wolf Pack earned a bowl bid in each of the last four seasons.

In 2021, Nevada placed three different pass catchers on the Fred Biletnikoff Award Watch List, including two-time All-Mountain West selections Romeo Doubs and Cole Turner. The receiving corps helped power a Wolf Pack passing game that finished fourth nationally.

Prior to his time at Nevada, Chang had two stints as an offensive coordinator. In 2016, he served as the offensive coordinator at Emory & Henry College in Virginia. During that season the Wasps averaged 33.0 points and 463.5 yards per game.

Previously, Chang spent two seasons at Jackson State University in Jackson, Miss., as his run-and-shoot offense had the Tigers humming as well. Jackson State led the Southwestern Athletic Conference and finished among the leaders nationally in multiple offensive categories, including passing yardage, completions, completion percentage and total offense.

Chang first got his coaching start as an offensive assistant at SMU under his collegiate head coach, June Jones, for two seasons. He assisted in all aspects of the Mustangs' offense with a primary focus on the Mustang quarterbacks. In Chang's first season in 2012, SMU earned an invite to the Hawai'i Bowl where they defeated Fresno State.

A four-year starter for Hawai'i from 2000-04, Chang set the NCAA's all-time passing (17,072) and total offense (16,910) records. The Honolulu native finished his career with 117 total touchdowns, which ranked third at the time. A two-time Hawai'i Bowl Most Outstanding Player, Chang led UH to three bowl appearances and a program-record 29 wins at guarterback. In his final season as a Warrior, he was a finalist for the Johnny Unitas Award, given to the nation's top senior quarterback.

Following his illustrious collegiate career at UH, Chang played professional football in the National Football League, Canadian Football League, and NFL Europe for four seasons. He retired from professional football in 2009 and returned to Hawai'i to complete his bachelor's degree.

- ▶ Head coach **Timmy Chang** is one of 22 minority head coaches in FBS football and one of three Polynesians (Kalani Sitake-BYU and Ken Niumatalolo-Navy). Among the full-time assistant coaches, UH is tied with Miami (Fla.) for the national lead with eight minority assistants.
- ▶ In addition to **Chang** (2000-04), several former Warriors are on the coaching staff: ILB coach Chris Brown (1998-2002), CB coach Abe Elimimian (2001-04), RB coach Keiki Misipeka (2001), QC Jordan Pu'u-Robinson (2012-14), GA Alema Kapoi (2020-21), and intern Samson Anguay (2013-14, '16).
- ▶ Among the full-time staff, Chang coached with both Thomas Sheffield and Josh Brown at Nevada. In addition, Silas Clapham (Dir. of Player Personnel), Cade Socha (Quality Control) and Jimbo Davis (Quality Control) also were on staff at Nevada.
- Elimimian enters his eighth season on the coaching staff while working for his fifth head coach (Norm Chow, Chris Naeole-interim, Nick Rolovich, Todd Graham, Timmy Chang). The former UH cornerback earned first-team all-conference honors and played in three bowl games. His younger brother Solomon (2005-08) is UH's all-time tackles leader and retired CFL linebacker, who was the league's Most Outstanding Player in 2014.
- ▶ Defensive coordinator Jacob Yoro, who joined the program in 2017, spent one season as co-coordinator in 2020. Yoro, who prepped at powerhouse Saint Louis School under legendary coach and former UH assistant Cal Lee, previously served as DC at Pacific University (Ore.) from 2010-14.
- ▶ WR coach Jared Ursua is the older brother of former UH receiver John Ursua.
- > OC lan Shoemaker and DL coach Eti Ena both coached at Eastern Washigton last season. Prior to EWU, Shoemaker was head coach at Central Washington from 2014-19 while accumulating a win percentage of .704. In addition to Shoemaker, Ena coached alongside Yoro and Josh Brown at Cal Poly.
- > OL coach Roman Sapolu's father is former UH All-American Jesse Sapolu, who earned four Super Bowl rings with the San Francisco 49ers. Brother Landon also suited up for the Rainbow Warriors.
- ▶ LB coach **Chris Brown** still owns two UH weightlifting records—bench press (500lbs) and squat (605lbs).
- ▶ The 11 full-time coaches have a combined 35 children. RB coach Keiki Misipeka has eight children, all of whom begin with the letter K and have Hawaiian first names.

#### **GAME NOTES**

- ▶ Vanderbilt wins the first meeting between the teams. The teams will meet next year (2023) in Nashville.
- ▶ UH dropped to 3-10-1 all-time against current SEC teams (3-6-1 at home).
- ▶ UH suffered its largest home defeat at since falling to USC 62-7 in 1999.
- ▶ The Warriors scored the first touchdown of the game, but Vanderbilt 49 unanwered points in the final three quarters, including a 35-point third quarter.
- ▶ Mike Wright's 87-yard touchdown run in the third quarter was the second-longest run ever by a UH opponent.
- ▶ The Commodores scored a pair of defensive touchdowns, both on fumble returns. It had been six years since a UH opponent scored on a fumble return.
- ▶ Junior wide receiver Jonah Panoke racked up career highs in both receptions (7) and receiving yards (101)
- ▶ Virdel Edwards II and Leonard Lee led UH with a career-high six tackles each.
- ▶ Edwards and Lee were among 13 players to make their first career starts as Rainbow Warriors. Eight were on defense and five on offense.
- ▶ Matthew Shipley nailed a 40-yard field goal in the second quarter. He's now made 12 straight field goals from 40 yards and in dating back to last season.

#### **GAME NOTES**

- ▶ UH fell in the first-ever meeting between the teams.
- ▶ The Rainbow Warriors started the season 0-2 for the first time since 2016.
- It was UH's second straight home loss to start the season. The last time that happened was in 2014 (Washington and Oregon State).
- ▶ UH turned the ball over six times, with the Hilltoppers capitalizing for 28 points off of those turnovers.
- ▶ Quarterbacks Brayden Schager and Joey Yellen combined to throw five interceptions, with Schager throwing four and Yellen one. UH's last five-interception game was in the 2010 Hawai'i Bowl.
- ▶ Three UH quarterbacks Yellen, Schager and Cammon Cooper saw action within the first 1.5 quarters of action.
- ▶ Nasjzae Bryant-Lelei scored his first career touchdown as a Rainbow Warrior with a 1-yard plunge in the fourth quarter.
- ▶ UH benefitted from its first two turnovers of the season.
- ▶ The Warriors defense recorded its first turnover of the season with Malik Hausman's interception in the third quarter.

- $\blacktriangleright$  The Warriors got their first two sacks of the season with takeowns by both Blessman Taʻala and John Tuitupou.
- ▶ UH had just one penalty for 10 yards, its lowest total since its 2018 win over Navy.
- ▶ Hawai'i dropped to 9-25 overall against current members of the Big Ten conference, including a 1-11 road record.
- ▶ UH played before its second biggest crowd in history (110,012). The top mark was six years ago at Michigan (110,222).
