





New Yorker's View of the World

1946 – Penn State University - ENIAC Constructed and operated at the Moore School of Electrical Engineering to solve mathematical problems.

ENIAC - Electronic Numerical Integrator and Computer Constructed and operated at the Moore School of Electrical Engineering.

1951 – MIT Whirlwind Computer

First with core memory and graphics - adopted by the U.S. Air Force for use in the SAGE (Semi-Automatic Ground Environment) air defense system, which became operational in 1958 with more advanced display capabilities.




Corridor system






Hub and spoke System pioneered by Delta for their airline routes – but also became transportation plan for our cities


Hub and spoke design is also the design for networks






