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Inspired Floorcoverings have designed a carpet to withstand high traffic commercial environments, however without regular maintenance the appearance of the carpet will begin to be affected, therefore reducing the lifespan of the carpet.

Carpet Tile Care: Keeping Them Clean and Lasting Longer

To get the most out of your carpet tiles, you must reduce the soil traffic, remove any soil, remove any spots and stains and clean thoroughly and regularly using professional and qualified commercial cleaning companies that use the correct and professional equipment. It is essential for long-term performance .

Preventative care is also essential for increasing the lifespan of your carpet tiled floor.

- All outside entrance ways, carpark areas and walkways should be swept and cleaned thoroughly and regularly to minimise the amount of soil that gets on to the carpeted floor.
- Large barrier matting or walk-off mats, help remove soil from shoes and can hold large amounts of soil in their piles preventing them from entering the building.
- Plastic mats should be placed under all chairs and desks to prevent fibre damage and chair casters rubbing dirt into the carpet.
- Immediate removal of spots and spills between scheduled cleaning to prevent permanent stains, therefore increasing the lifespan of the carpet.
- A regular weekly vacuum clean is essential for the maintenance of your carpet tiled floor. Vacuuming removes dirt particles preventing them from causing fibre damage.
